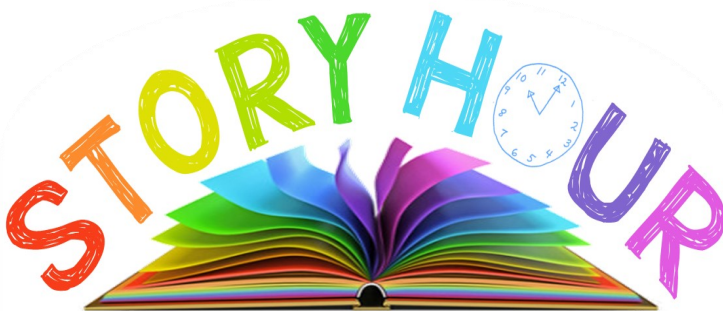
Summer Reading Program: Libraries Rock!

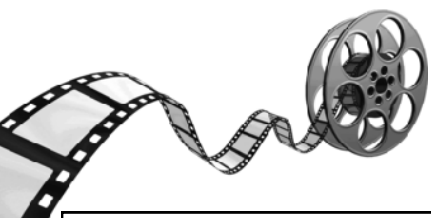
