## BLT DIP

This is so easy and so good!

## INGREDIENTS:

1 lb . bacon
1 c. mayonnaise
1 c . sour cream
1 tomato - peeled, seeded and diced
Lettuce leaves

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Place bacon in large, deep skillet and cook over medium high heat until crisp. Drain on paper towels.
In medium mixing bowl combine mayo and sour cream. Add crumbled bacon. Stir in tomato just before serving.
Place in a lettuce leaf lined bowl. Serve with Fritos and/or tortilla chips.

## RED, WHITE AND BLUE JELL-O SHOTS

Celebrate Independence Day with these colorful shots.

## INGREDIENTS:

8 strawberries diced
1-3 oz. box Strawberry Jell-O
2-3 oz. boxes Berry Blue Jell-O
Cool Whip
Blueberries for garnish
3 c . boiling water
1-1/2 c. vodka
Cold water
2 oz . shot cups (about 25)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

## To make the red layer:

Pour $1 / 2$ cup of vodka into a large measuring cup. Add water to make 1 cup total. Place cup in the fridge to chill.
Boil 1 cup of water and pour into the measuring cup.
Dice strawberries into small pieces and place a few into each shot cup.
Empty Strawberry Jell-O powder into a large mixing bowl and add one cup of boiling water.
Stir continuously until the Jell-O is completely dissolved. About 2 minutes.
Add cup of cold vodka and water.
Stir until mixed and pour into shot cups filled $1 / 2$ of the way. Refrigerate until firm.
To make the blue layer:
Pour 1 cup of vodka into a large measuring cup. Add water to make 2 cups total. Place cup in the fridge to chill.
Boil 2 cups of water.
Empty 2 packages of Blueberry Jell-O powder into a large mixing bowl and add 2 cups of boiling water.
Stir continuously until the Jell-O is completely dissolved. About 2 minutes.
Add 2 cups of cold vodka and water.
Stir until mixed and pour on top of the red layer of Jell-O. If the red layer is not totally set, the strawberries will float to the top.
No worries - it is all yummy. You just don't want the colors to mix.

Refrigerate until firm.
To serve:
Remove from refrigerator, top with whipped cream and a couple of
blueberries. Serve immediately. These will melt in the sun, so keep in a cooler or the fridge until time to serve. Cheers!
