Dear Members and Friends of the DCCW,

The Annual Convention of the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women for the year 2023 will be on Saturday, April 22nd and Sunday, April 23rd at the Sheraton Hotel, 150 West 500 South, Salt Lake City. Each year, a designated feature of the convention is the honoring of each parish's Woman of the Year at the banquet on Saturday night. If you have not chosen a Woman of the Year from your parish in the past, please consider doing so for 2023. We need to hear the stories of these select women and the many blessings they bring to our parishes. Should there be no functioning woman's council in your parish, your pastor may choose a woman worthy of this honor.



The Woman of the Year award is given in recognition to the woman who goes over and beyond in service to her parish. She may be behind the scenes, or she may be the more visible woman in the parish who is active in the organizations and ministries and who serves time after time. To be considered also, are the women who serve by maintaining the church and all that entails as well as an older woman who is no longer able to contribute but should be honored for her many years of past service.

However, only one woman may be selected for this honor. "When you lift up one, you lift up all."

If this is the first year of participation for your woman's council or if you would like to try a new way to make your Woman of the Year selection, the following are "suggested" methods:

- 1. A committee of your woman's council, possibly including past Women of the Year, could meet and choose the woman;
- 2. The parishioners may vote for a woman and explain why she should be chosen;
- 3. Your woman's organization could choose the lady or submit names for which parishioners can vote;
- 4. If the parish is unaffiliated with DCCW or has no woman's group, the pastor may choose the woman.

To assure complete and proper recognition of your Woman of the Year, we must receive her name and a brief biographical resume and a photo by Monday, March 15th. Medals must be ordered and engraved and names printed in the convention program so there are time constraints. We also need a "brief" resume (100 words or less) about her, expressing why she was chosen as Woman of the Year from your parish. Ariel Durian. We would like to suggest that your parish or woman's organization help pay for her convention experience as a tribute to a most deserving woman.
