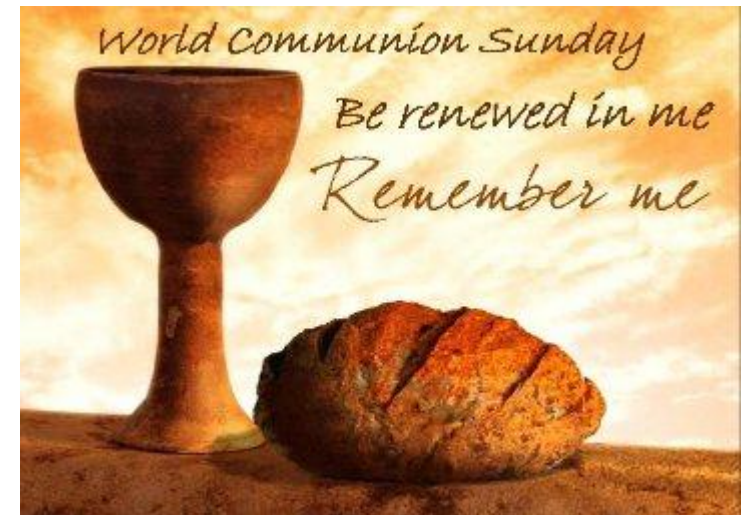
Do This in Remembrance of Me (1 Corinthians 11:23-27)
