Termites

Termites

- broad waist
- wings are equal length
- straight antennae
- workers light in color (almost white)
- lose wings quickly after swarming
- 3/8" to 1/2" including wings

Ants

- three distinct sections of the body
- two pairs of unequal sized wings
- elbowed antennae
- workers look similar to winged versions
- do not lose wings quickly after swarming
- ranging in size depending on ant species

How Are Termites Removed?

The system used treats the termites in your home in a way that will remove the colony and not just the surface invaders. Termites can live underground, so it is important to manage the whole area to prevent repeat infestations. A.W.E.S.O.M.E. uses Premise, a non-repellent substance that will adhere to termites that come in contact with the substance, and they will then carry it back to the colony. This slower acting control allows all the termites to be eliminated with no possibility of a return invasion. The liquid treatment is injected into the soil where any potential foraging termites will pass through it. This stops termites from re-infesting.

Description of Treatment

Permise is applied in the soil along the exterior foundation walls to create a continuous treatment zone around the structure. The substance remains in the soil as a barrier guarding the perimeter of your home. Any new invaders must march through the barrier. The substance sticks to the new invaders and they carry it back to their colony and termite trouble becomes a thing of the past.
