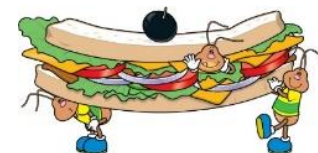
Today!

Donors can write a check for their Erie Gives donation. **Checks must be made out to The Erie Community Foundation**. All check donations must be accompanied by a Check Donation Form. Checks must be delivered to The Erie Community Foundation (459 W. 6th St., Erie, PA 16507) no later than Mon., August 8. **You'll find Check Contribution forms on the table in the narthex.**

If you donate by credit card only Visa, MasterCard and Discover will be accepted. The credit card processor charges a nominal fee per transaction. The Erie Community Foundation does not receive any fees. Sorry, credit card gift cards will not be accepted.

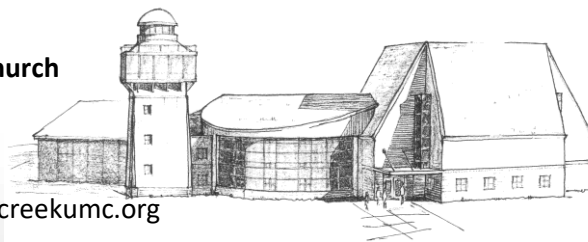
