From the Board President - Joy Mee

This year we were fortunate to hear Dr. Brad Stock, Distinguished Professor of the History of the Christian Science Movement at Principia College. The title of his talk was "Mary Baker Eddy: A Lifetime of Christian Service." Brad reminded us that we are humanitarians and benevolent by definition as Christian Scientists. What an inspiring message about Mrs. Eddy's practice of Christianity and lifetime of service! It was also gratifying to hear how Glenmont (a Christian Science nursing facility in Ohio at which Brad was the Director for a time) overcame a lack of funds by realizing that their source of supply was from God, not people. This understanding motivated them to restore the availability of financial aid for patients. As their thought shifted from finances to service, they had an abundance of patients who could pay. So the lessons are that Christian charity and service equal benevolence, and that giving never impoverishes us.

Your Board wants you to be aware that Desert View has had a policy of providing short-term benevolence on a case-by-case basis. Even though we operate at a deficit, we believe that we are here to serve. We are grateful that we have been able to provide benevolence in several cases to those wishing Christian Science nursing care.

We hope those who attended our annual meeting enjoyed this education about Mrs. Eddy's history with, and concept of, benevolence. It is our gift to the Christian Science community and our loyal supporters. From the Board Treasurer - Don Johnson

The year 2015 was a good year financially for the Desert View facility. The nursing and administrative staffs held expenses within the budgeted amounts. In addition, though it was projected that we would have a 20% income to expense shortfall, the year ended with a shortfall of only 4%. This was made possible by additional patient and investment revenue, and increased individual contributions in the fourth quarter of the year.

The financial goal of Desert View is to become income and expense neutral so shortfalls do not need to be taken from the reserve funds.

We would like to thank everyone who contributed to Desert View for their spiritual and financial support, and remind you that all your financial contributions to Desert View are tax deductible.
