- Sign up for a tree before November 1. Contact the ACCVB office. Cassidy Bringle, events coordinator.

- Cost to sign up: \$35 for families and nonprofit groups. \$50 for businesses/ merchants. The donation helps defray the cost of the event. Remember money raised at Tannenbaum Forest will be donated to the Stead Family University of Iowa Children's Hospital in Iowa City. When ordering your tree please make checks payable to Amana Colonies Festivals, Inc. mail or drop payment attn: Events Coordinator at ACCVB Office, 622 46th Ave. Amana, IA. 52203.

- You are responsible for decorating your tree. Let your imagination run wild a bit. Theme trees are great, but not required and there are lots of fun ideas out there so feel free to be truly creative. You will need to provide your own tree skirt (if you wish one) decorations, lights and extension cord. Bring a ladder and any other tools necessary to complete your tree. Participants are required to set up and tear down their tree at the designated dates and times.

(if you are not able to tear down at the designated time an additional \$50 fee will be charged and decorations forfeited.)

- Please volunteer if you can. Volunteers will be needed in the forest. Contact Emilie Hoppe at zhoppe@southslope.net to sign up for your volunteer shift. You'll be sent a sign up sheet with dates/times.

- All trees will be decorated from Monday, November 25th from Noon-8 pm; and Tuesday, November 22nd from 8am-5 pm. No early arrivals to pick out your tree before noon unless you also help decorate uptown. If you arrive early, to help decorate the fence at the front of town at 8am, you may pick out your tree before noon.

- Teardown and clean-up will be December 23rd beginning at 8am. Please be sure that you or your designee will be able to come at this time to avoid clean up penalty and forfeiting your decorations.
