SWINE ARE THE ONLY ANIMALS THAT WILL BE STAYING OVERNIGHT

- Masks will be worn in any of the barns at all times.
- Exhibitors will wear masks in the show ring.
- Displays are not allowed.
- No Parking areas will be roped off and enforced.
- Shavings will NOT be supplied.
- No gate charge
- Social distancing will be required on the grounds and in the arena bleachers.
- All entries (including Showmanship) will be made on-line. <u>THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES DAY OF SHOW.</u>

RULE 1. ELIGIBILITY: Participation in the Goat Show Division is limited to members in good standing with their 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Exhibitors must be enrolled in and attending, public or private elementary or secondary school or living in the Southwest Fair District area. Exhibitors may be ages 9-19 and may be in their first semester of college.

RULE 2. ALL goats must have a Premise Ear ID Tag following rules of the Arkansas Livestock & Poultry Commission. MUST BE OFFICIAL USDA TAG, AND CAN BE ORDERED VIA USDA AT (866)873-2824.

RULE 3. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries will close at midnight September 15, 2020. Please bring your ShoWorks receipt with you. In all cases, the management reserves the right to accept or reject an application for entry.

RULE 5. Arrival will be the day of the show, Friday October 2nd. Registration and self-weights are from 8am-9am. Weights <u>MUST</u> be turned in by 9am. *IF YOU ARE NOT READY WHEN YOUR CLASS IS CALLED YOU WILL BE SCRATCHED!*

RULE 4. RELEASE: You may leave as soon as you are done showing, premium checks will be mailed at a later date. Be sure to clean up after yourself and your animals. Failure to do so can cause your premium check to be held. NO SMOKING IN BARNS.

RULE 5. Exhibitor must be able to have full control of animal or risk disqualification.

RULE 6. Southwest Arkansas District Fair and officials shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to property or the owners thereof.

RULE 7. Only animals that are credible from the standpoint of type, quality and finish shall be eligible for judging. The judge may, at his/her discretion, award placing according to the animal's quality; therefore, a single entry is not automatically awarded first place.

RULE 8. ALL PROTESTS SHALL BE MADE TO THE LIVESTOCK CHAIRMAN IN WRITING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF JUDGING. SUCH PROTESTS MUST STATE PLAINLY THE CAUSE OF COMPLAINT AND BE ACCOMPANIED BY \$100 DEPOSIT. JUDGING PROCEDURES WILL NOT BE INTERRUPTED FOR PROTEST INVESTIGATION. DECISIONS OF THE LIVESTOCK SHOW CHAIRMAN ARE FINAL, PENDING A COMPLETE INVESTIGATION.

RULE 9. Showmanship classes will be judged after Dairy Goats. Classes: Ages 9-12, Ages 13-15, Ages 16-19. Exhibitors use their actual date of birth to determine which class to enter. **THIS YEAR YOU MUST REGISTER ONLINE FOR SHOWMANSHIP.** A \$5 entry fee must be paid upon entering ring the day of show. Money will be jackpotted; winner take all. Each exhibitor entering Showmanship must show his/her own animal.

MARKET GOATS

1. Wethers and does may be shown.

- 2. Any breed of goat or cross may be shown.
- 3. Market Wether & Market Does will be broken into classes by weight. Minimum weight will be 50 lbs. with no maximum weight. Weights must be turned in by 9am.
- 3. Goats may be horned, but horns must be tipped.
- 4. \$5.00 of each entry will be placed in Jackpot and will be paid as follows: 60% Grand Champion 40% Reserve Champion
- 5. Limit three entries per exhibitor.

DAIRY GOATS

- 1. There must be five animals to constitute a breed. All other breeds will be shown as All Other Breeds
- 2. All animals must have registration papers. Females without registration papers will be shown as commercial does.
- 3.If a doe is shown in a wethers class, it is not eligible to be shown in breed class.
- 4. No buck goats are allowed on the fairgrounds.
- 5. There will be a limit of three entries per exhibitor.
