**CACAGNY Calls on DeBlasio to

The Chinese American Citizens Alliance of Greater New York (CACAGNY) applauds the Chinese parents of New York City for their activism in response to the deplorable language CEC 22 member Jackie Cody used to describe East Asians. CACAGNY also thanks New York City Councilmember Chaim Deutsch for his support of the Chinese Community.

But the easy disparagement with which Jackie Cody pitted one racial group against another is just a direct result of the divisive, racist, bigoted, hostile, persecutorial animus that permeates all through the Department of Education under Richard Carranza's chancellorship. It's the same animus that left San Francisco's public schools deep in racial strife as well as demoralized in utter educational failure.

This incident is but one of many, many proofs that Carranza is totally unacceptable as Chancellor for New York City. We demand Mayor DeBlasio correct his mistake in hiring Richard Carranza by dismissing him immediately.
