
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON MEETING OF THE MINDS





Time to book your room for the Memorial Day Parrot Head Palooza and Captain Hiram's in Sebastian, FL.



EASTER EGG JELL-O SHOTS

I use several different colors for a festive display.

INGREDIENTS:

4 - 3 oz. boxes of different flavored Jell-O. I like lemon, raspberry, grape and orange.

1 c. boiling water per box

1 c. cold vodka per box

Plastic Easter eggs

Empty egg cartons

INSTRUCTIONS:

In four different bowls, mix each separate flavor of Jell-O with boiling water. Stir until dissolved. Add cold vodka and stir until blended. Place the bottom half of each plastic egg in the egg carton

compartments. Fill just below the top with Jell-O. Chill about 4 hours, or until set. Put plastic egg top on for displaying.

BAKED POTATO, HAM AND EGG CASSEROLE

This is a favorite way to use your leftover Easter ham, potatoes and eggs.

INGREDIENTS:

2 medium cooked potatoes, peeled and sliced

4 hard-boiled large eggs, chopped

1 1/4 c. diced fully cooked ham

1/2 t. salt

1/4 t. pepper

1 large egg

1 1/2 c. sour cream

8 oz. shredded Swiss cheese

1/4 c. dry bread crumbs

1 T. butter, melted

INSTRUCTIONS:

In a large bowl, combine the potatoes, eggs, ham, salt and pepper. Combine the egg and sour cream; add to potato mixture and gently toss to coat. Transfer to a greased 11x7 in. baking dish.

Toss bread crumbs and butter. Put cheese on top and sprinkle with crumbs. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 20 minutes or until a thermometer reaches 160°.
