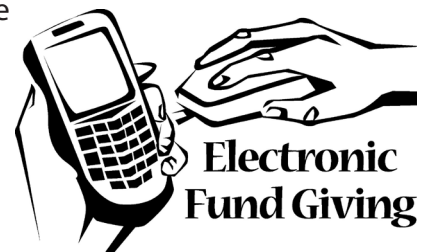
Electronic Giving

Memorial Day Service, Sunday, May 27, 2017

After the 9:00 Service (Note: only one service beginning May 27)

Please join us for a special Memorial Service on Sunday, May 27, at the Remembrance Garden, located just west of the church entrance. The Memorial Service will take place after the 9:00 a.m. worship service. We will be remembering members of Trinity and their families who fell asleep in Christ. Flowers will be provided to place at a tree or in the Garden or to take home, in memory of your loved one.

Years ago on Memorial Day, families had the ability to visit the cemetery where loved ones were buried and place flowers on the grave. As families became scattered, Trinity members decided to start a tradition in the late 1990's, honoring our loved ones with a "Remembrance Garden". Trees were dedicated to those who had passed, and a brass plate with their name, birth and death dates were placed with them. When we ran out of trees on the property, a lovely flower garden was created in 2008, and donations were made in memory of loved ones.

Return on Spiritual Investments

Are you getting a return on your spiritual investment? In the last edition of this newsletter, I wrote about making a personal deposit in Christ, banking with God. Personally committing your life to Jesus Christ is your deposit, and through this action you receive a gift greater than any other.

Paul reminds us, "Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you--guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us." 2 Timothy 1:14 (NIV). Steven J. Cole writes, when you trust in Christ to save you, you are admitting, "I cannot save myself by my own efforts or good works. Although I am a sinner, I am confident that Jesus Christ can save me. I am entrusting my eternal destiny to Him. I am taking God at His Word by believing that Christ will do what He promised, namely, to give eternal life to every person who believes in Him."

Are you connecting with your advisor to learn about protecting your investment? Are you guarding your investment against fraudsters or thieves? Are you nurturing your investment to increase its value? The church is set up to be an investment and a development center. Are you plugged in? 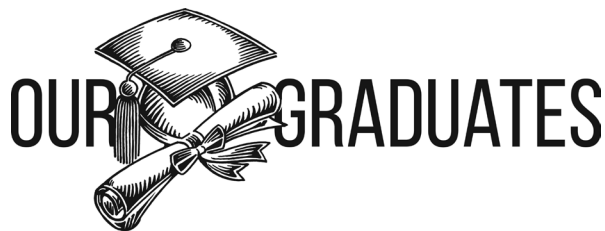
To Easter Breakfast Helpers

2018 Women's Conference "Worry Less! Live More"

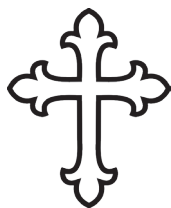
