We hope the Linnville Branch will be reopening soon. We will keep you posted. Make sure to check our social media for the most up to date information.

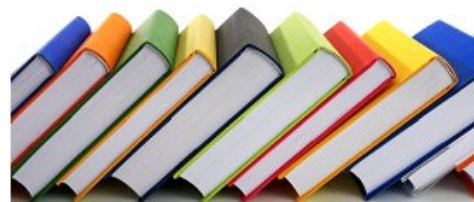

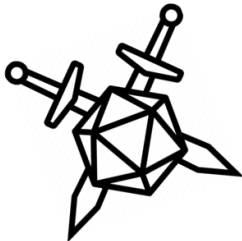
