

Family Members (Residing in your home): Please do not list adult children who do not live with you; they will be considered your guest(s). Children 3 and over will need to have a pool wrist band to enter into the facility.



- All family members and guests must follow the pool rules that are posted at the pool.
- You are allowed up to five bands per household and each band will allow entry for one person. If you want guests, you must purchase additional wrist bands (\$5/each) up to a total of 10 per household.
- Pool bands will not be issued to members in arrears of their maintenance assessment charge in accordance with the Declaration and prior notification. If you are not sure if your assessment have been paid call 832-678-4500 to avoid any delays.
- If you're a homeowner please bring a valid ID showing your current address in the neighborhood.
- If you are a tenant, please bring a copy of your current lease along with a valid ID.
- Registration AFTER on-site registration is \$10.00 Administration Fee and forms may be processed via any of the mediums provided: e-mail, mail or at the office (information below).
- ON-SITE REGISTRATION AT THE POOL --- 2016 May 7<sup>th</sup>, 9am to 11am; May 12<sup>th</sup>; 5pm to 8pm; May 14<sup>th</sup>, 9am to 11am; May 21<sup>st</sup> 9am to 11am; May 28<sup>th</sup> 10am to 12pm, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 10am to 12pm and the Final Registration day will be June 9<sup>th</sup> from 6:30pm to 8:30pm.

#### PROTECT YOUR PRIVATE INFORMATION

Recently I attended a PIP meeting at our local HPD Store Front where they had a very interesting speaker talking about different ways thieves are trying to scam people and steal their identity. It was extremely informative so I wanted to share it with the HOA. The National Crime Prevention Council put together a report suggesting ways to protect your private information. - Karen Dollahon, BVW Board President Watch for Scams:

**Do business only with companies you know**, do not give out your credit card number to make a purchase or reservation unless you initiate the transaction.

**Be leery of door to door salesman with high pressure sales tactics**. *Do business with companies you know with references and liability insurance you can call and verify.* 

**Shop only at secure websites** that use encryption software to transfer data from your computer to the merchant and that have strong privacy and security policies.

**Do not respond to emails asking you to "update" your credit card information** even if they appear to be from the company that issued you the credit card. Call the company directly to verify what information is needed.

If you receive pre-approved credit card offers in the mail, do not throw them in the trash without shredding them first.

If you are expecting new credit cards in the mail and they do not arrive, or you do not receive your bills at the expected time, call the credit card issuer immediately.

**Check your credit card bills carefully** for several months after purchasing on the Internet. If you find purchases you did not make, immediately contact the credit card company and file a dispute claim.

Get a copy of your credit report once a year and review it for any unexpected activity.

**Grandparent Scam** is a scam currently played on seniors when the caller pretends to be a grandchild needing money for an emergency and asks them to send prepaid money cards.

**IRS Scam** a person calls you pretending to be an agent claiming you owe the government money and unless paid, they claim they will send over a deputy to arrest you.

The entire report will be posted on our community website with more information and links on how to report illegal activity.

-Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged in City of Houstonapproved biodegradable bags and is collected weekly with regular trash pickup.

-City Trash Collection occurs every Thursday.

-Recycling occurs every other Thursday
