Report from Prop Manager, Rob Martin:

- Friday football set up at Challenger went smoothly, especially with the new trailer. It was an organized set up with help from Ms. Wood and the new CCHS Band Director.
- Security is challenging with new safety measures. Only 5 wristbands allow entrance onto field for security and into booth for announcers.

Treasurer Report:
