UCF was +30 ATS points vs Temple in a 49-7 win (-12).  
The Bowling Green/Buffalo game went OVER the total by 48.5 points!  
The Virginia/BUU game went OVER the total by 48.5 points!  
Syracuse is 8-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 8.1 ppg!  
UTSA is 7-1 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 10.2 ppg!  
Missouri has failed to cover the spread in 11 straight games by an average of 11 ppg.  
The OVER is 6-2 in Pitt games going OVER by an average of 10.1 ppg!  
The UNDER is 8-1 in Illinois games going UNDER by an average of 10.1 ppg!

#### Misleading Finals

**Bowling Green upset Buffalo 56-44.** However, Buffalo had an incredible 36-11 first down edge but were -2 in TO's. Buffalo ran 99 plays to BG's 46! Obviously, BG was the more explosive team with a 10.5-5.0 yards per play advantage.

**Michigan St upset Michigan 37-33.** However, Michigan had a 552-395 yard edge and led 30-14 mid-way through the 3Q.

**NC State beat Louisville 28-13.** However, Louisville had a 434-361 yard edge including 215-44 on the ground. NC State outscored Louisville 21-3 in the 4Q! N.C. State had only 189 yards of total offense through three quarters. The Cardinals managed 55 yards on three fourth-quarter possessions.

**Georgia St beat Georgia Southern 21-14.** However, Georgia Southern had a 486-378 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. Georgia St scored on a 23-yard run with 26 seconds remaining.



**Washington St upset Arizona St 34-21.** However, ASU had a 406-400 yard edge but were -4 in TO's. Washington St did lead 28-0 in the 2Q and Arizona St scored two TD's in the final 5 minutes of the game..

**Middle Tennessee beat Southern Miss 35-10.** However, MT scored three non-offensive TD's. A 18-yard blocked punt TD, a 29-yard fumble return TD and a 43-yard interception return TD.

**Purdue upset Nebraska 28-23.** However, Nebraska had a 399-349 yard edge but were -4 in TO's including a 45-yard interception return TD.

#### Bad Beats

**Florida St at Clemson** was the bad beat of the year. We're sure you all saw it so we won't go into particulars but Clemson got a fumble return TD on the final play after a failed multiple lateral attempt by Florida St. It gave Clemson (-9.5) backers the cover and also put the game OVER the 47.5 total. It was the first time all game that Clemson was covering. It also broke their 8-game ATS losing streak dating back to last year.

Indiana QB's Michael Penix (shoulder) and Jack Tuttle (lower body) are questionable for this week's game at Michigan.  
Louisiana Tech QB Austin Kendall is questionable for this week's game vs UAB.  
Memphis QB Seth Henigan (hand) is questionable vs SMU.  
Middle Tennessee QB Chase Cunningham is questionable vs WKU.  
Ole Miss QB Matt Corral (ankle) is probable vs Liberty.  
Minnesota RB Bryce Williams (leg) is out for the season. Minnesota has only two scholarship RB's now on the roster.  
Missouri QB Connor Bazelak is probable vs Georgia.  
Pitt WR Taysir Mack (arm) and RB Israel Abanikanda are questionable vs Duke.  
Rice QB Jake Constantine has been named the starter vs Charlotte.  
SMU RB's Ulysses Bentley and TJ McDaniel are both questionable vs Memphis.  
Stanford QB Tanner McKee is questionable vs Utah.  
Tulane QB Michael Pratt (head) is questionable vs Central Florida.  
USC WR Drake London (ankle) is out for the season.  
Wyoming WR Ayden Eberhardt (knee) is out indefinitely.

TCU head coach Gary Patterson is out at TCU after over 20 years as coach of the Horned Frogs, the school announced on Sunday night. In meeting with the longtime coach Sunday, school officials asked Patterson to finish this season, but he declined. Instead, Patterson will be replaced by Jerry Kill, an assistant on his staff, on an interim basis. Patterson arrived at TCU as Dennis Franchione's defensive coordinator in 1998 and took over as head coach in 2001. He went 181-79 at TCU and oversaw the Horned Frogs' rise from being left behind after the breakup of the Southwest Conference back through Conference USA, the Mountain West and back into the Big 12, largely due to the success the school had under Patterson.

#### Recapping Week 9 Best Bets

Our College best bets went 2-3 with both of our top plays winning. North Carolina had back-door potential but finished the game at the Notre Dame 4-yard line. SMU gave up a 100-yard kick return TD in the final seconds in a game that looked like it was heading to OT. The Louisiana Tech/Old Dominion OVER recommendation was just a bad pick. The NFL was beyond frustrating to finish 1-2. We won outright with the Patriots but lost in OT with the Colts (line closed Indy -3). Despite a 6-point line move with Dak Prescott being a late scratch, our top play on Minnesota lost.

## Games in Rotation Order

### Wednesday, November 3rd

**KENT ST 34 Northern Illinois 31.** Maction continues with a solid match-up here and a possible MAC Championship preview with both leading their divisions. Both have similar ypp margins (Kent -0.26 vs NIU -0.65) while playing similar schedules in terms of strength. Early professional money has been on Northern Illinois here and anything above 3 is a slight lean on the dog.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN 35 Central Michigan 26.** WMU has won 6 of the last 7 in the series. WMU has been the superior team in the stats this year (+0.12 ypp vs CMU -0.3) and has played the tougher schedule. We lean CMU here but prefer the UNDER.

### Thursday, November 4th

**UL-LAFAYETTE 34 Georgia St 20.** ULL -10 was one of our favorite bets we made on the Sunday openers this week. First, ULL is superior in the stats ranking No. 23 in ppg margin, No. 44 in ypp margin and No. 50 in ypp margin while Georgia St ranks No. 101 in ppg, No. 99 in ypp and No. 93 in ypp. It's also a bad spot for Georgia St traveling on a short week off a last-second rivalry win. Meanwhile, ULL is fresh off a 45-0 beat down at home of Texas St.

### Friday, November 5th

**Virginia Tech 24 BOSTON COLLEGE 22.** Winner here gets a much-needed boost as far as bowl hopes down the stretch. BC might be slightly better in the stats but the Eagles have played a weaker schedule than VT. BC is reeling with 4 straight losses as their offense is averaging just 10 ppg in those games. Meanwhile, VT snapped a 5-game ATS losing streak with their outright upset over Georgia Tech last week. That saved head coach Justin Fuente's job for another week. We're not involved here.

**Utah 31 STANFORD 23.** Utah is the far superior teams in all of the major stats categories including ypp margin (+0.93 vs -0.06). With Pac-12 bottom feeders (Arizona and Colorado) still left on the schedule, a win here will basically clinch a Pac-12 title game berth for the Utes. Meanwhile, Stanford has lost 3 straight since their upset over Oregon. The Cardinal are likely to be sitting at home for the holidays for a 3rd straight season. We bet Utah -6 on the Sunday openers but crossing through a key "7" number has reduced the value.

### Saturday, November 6th

**† Air Force 20 Army 17.** @Choctaw Stadium in Arlington, TX. Both teams come in off a bye and both have question marks at QB. Christian Anderson (Army) and Haaziq Daniels are questionable but reading the tea leaves early in the week, we think both will play. Air Force is on a 19-5 SU/16-7-1 ATS run in the series. AF is better in the stats (No. 60 in ypp margin vs No. 104) but Army has played the tougher schedule. The UNDER is on a 39-9-1 run in Service Academy games but that is more than priced into this line. Slightest of leans on AF here.

**Pittsburgh 42 DUKE 21.** At one point from the end of the Georgia Tech game through most of the Wake Forest game, Duke had been outscored 100-0 by its opponents. David Cutcliffe has far exceeded expectations in his tenure at Duke but this program has really slipped the last couple of years. On the other side, Pitt couldn't handle success and lost outright to Miami at home last week. They are the far superior team in the stats (No. 15 vs No. 103 in ypp margin) but we don't want to lay 3 TD's on the road. We bet OVER 59.5 on the Sunday openers but even that value is gone. Pass.

**NC State 28 FLORIDA ST 24.** Noles backers suffered the worst beat of the entire year last week in their 30-20 loss to Clemson (see page 1). FSU has turned their season around since that 0-4 start. Meanwhile, NC State got a bounce back win over Louisville last week but the 28-13 was misleading (see page 1). The Noles have taken some money in the market early this week dropping this number down off a key "3". Stats wise the teams are similar with NC State No. 36 in ypp margin and FSU No. 39. We actually lean with the road favorite though and also the UNDER.

**MIAMI, FL 35 Georgia Tech 24.** The Hurricanes certainly did not quit on their coach Manny Diaz as they've covered 3 straight after the bye and have pulled back-to-back outright upsets over ranked teams. QB Tyler Van Dyke seems to be a better passer than D'Eriq King. But now Miami is laying double-digits and we will see how they handle success. However, GT under Geoff Collins has been a disappointment so far in his tenure. Our power ratings say Miami is the play but we prefer the UNDER.

**Wisconsin 27 RUTGERS 13.** After a disastrous 1-3 start, this Wisconsin team has won 4 straight and we expect them to win the West division of the Big Ten (they'll be favored in all their remaining games). The Badgers have the No. 1 defense in the country allowing just 214.6 ypg. They're taking on a Rutgers team that we won with on these pages last week in their win at Illinois. Still, the Scarlet Knights are No. 113 in the country in ypp margin and we don't see their offense having much success here.

**Clemson 24 LOUISVILLE 21.** Clemson finally got their first cover of the season last week but it wasn't deserved (see page 1). The Tigers offense ranks No. 114 in ypg, No. 112 in scoring and No. 111 in yards per play. They've been bailed out by their defense which allows just 15.3 ppg (No. 3) and 4.56 yards per play (No. 7). We don't want to lay more than a FG on the road with them. Louisville was better than the final indicated last week vs NC State.

**UAB 32 Louisiana Tech 19.** Louisiana Tech's offense has taken a major turn for the worse. After going up and down the field on teams like Mississippi St, NC State and SMU, they have averaged just 13 ppg the last 3 games in CUSA play (much to our dismay on these pages last week). Now they face a rested UAB defense off a bye. The Blazers rank in the Top 30 nationally in ypg allowed, ppg allowed and yards per play allowed. They should be plenty mad after losing outright as 24-point favorites to Rice in their last game. We didn't bet this game yet and don't expect to.

**Iowa 27 NORTHWESTERN 14.** Iowa comes in off back-to-back losses. You live by the turnover, you die by it. Iowa was +15 in TO's in their 6-0 start. They are -6 in their last two games. Meanwhile, Northwestern has really under-achieved so far his season at 2-6 ATS failing to cover by 8.6 ppg. Northwestern has won 4 of the last 5 meetings but we like Iowa here (bet the -11 on the Sunday open). Totals players note the UNDER is on a 12-4 run in the series.

**Houston 35 SOUTH FLORIDA 21.** Houston beat us on these pages last week in dramatic fashion as they got a 100-yard kick return TD in the final seconds. The Cougars were the better team though for much of the game and they now have the inside track to the AAC Championship game. They're taking on a USF team that has a couple extra days to prep after a loss to ECU. We have a slight lean to the OVER.

**MICHIGAN 37 Indiana 17.** How does Michigan handle the disappointment of blowing a 16-point lead vs "Little Brother" last week. It was yet another example of Harbaugh coming up short in a big game. With the exception of last week, these two teams have been on opposite ends of the ATS spectrum. Michigan is 6-2 ATS covering their games by 7.8 ppg while Indiana is 2-6 failing to cover by 8.8 ppg. The spot isn't great for Michigan but they are great bullies under Harbaugh and we look for a comfortable win. We bet OVER 49.5 on the Sunday openers.

**NORTH CAROLINA 38 Wake Forest 33.** Because the two teams were tired of not playing each other in conference play, they scheduled a 2-game home and home non-conference series. So this won't count in the ACC standings. What a sport! If it wasn't for North Carolina coming up short on these pages last week vs Notre Dame, we'd probably have them as a best bet here. The two teams are No. 31 and No. 32 in ypp margin but NC has played the tougher schedule. Wake might be feeling the unbeaten pressure now that the calendar has hit November. We bet North Carolina -2 and UNDER 78.5 on the openers.

**Coastal Carolina 40 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 19.** It will be interesting to see how engaged Coastal is down the stretch now that they lost control of their own destiny in the Sun Belt. They didn't cover as big favorites last week. However, they're taking on a Georgia Southern team that will probably be playing out the season at this point. They gave great effort last week vs rival Georgia St but now with an interim coach and a bowl unlikely what is their to play for? Coastal with a huge ypp margin edge (No. 2 vs No. 118).

**CENTRAL FLORIDA 36 Tulane 23.** Two teams heading in opposite directions. Tulane has lost 6 straight games and now bowl eligibility is out of reach. They gave a solid effort last week vs Cincy, but came up short. Third-string QB Kai Horton, a freshman, started for Tulane. He completed seven of 16 passes for 79 yards. He was intercepted twice and sacked four times. Starter Pratt is questionable here. UCF's defense has allowed just 14 total points in their last two games. We bet UCF -10 on the openers but there has been clear value lost.

**MINNESOTA 29 Illinois 15.** Minnesota has now won and covered 4 straight games since the disastrous upset loss as 30.5-point favorites to Bowling Green. The Gophers lead the West division of the Big Ten but still have big games vs Iowa and Wisconsin left. They are down to just 2 scholarship RB's now that three have been lost for the season due to injury. They're taking on an Illinois team that we faded successfully last week. However, we're not doing it again here. With a low total we don't want to lay more than 2 TD's.

**CINCINNATI 38 Tulsa 16.** Rematch of last year's AAC Championship game won on the final play by Cincinnati. The undefeated noose is tightening on Cincy as they have failed to cover big point spreads each of the last two weeks. They need style points and help from other teams as the playoff committee dealt them a major blow Tuesday night ranking them No. 6. Believe it or not, we think the Bearcats deserve it over Oregon and Michigan St. Cincy would be favored over both on a neutral field (see our power ratings). They're taking on a Tulsa team here that will probably be looking for a new coach by season's end. The Golden Hurricane lost for the 2nd time as a big favorite at home this season in their last game. *ESPN's College Gameday* will be on hand for the first time ever in Cincinnati. We don't see much value here.

**Kansas St 39 KANSAS 16.** Kansas St has won 12 in a row in this series and has covered 9 of those games. A week after nearly upsetting Oklahoma, it was same of Kansas last week getting crushed 55-3 vs Oklahoma St. The Jayhawks are now 1-6-1 ATS on the season failing to cover by 6.9 ppg. They are No. 128 in ypp margin, No. 129 in ypg margin and No. 129 in scoring margin. Meanwhile, Kansas St is now one win away from bowl eligibility. Series dominance continues here but we're not laying 24 on the road.

**Florida 34 SOUTH CAROLINA 17.** It's not been a good week for Florida head coach Dan Mullen. First, the Gators get destroyed by rival Georgia 34-7. That dropped them to just 4-7 straight up in their last 11 games dating back to last season. Then, Mullen downplays the importance of recruiting in a media session which is a very legitimate criticism of him. The Gators will get back on track here vs an over-matched South Carolina team but we can't trust UF laying this kind of number. Lean SC who is off a bye.

**EAST CAROLINA 37 Temple 19.** Temple looks like a team that may have waved the white flag on the season. They were destroyed by Cincinnati in what was a favorable spot for them. They got out-gained by 300 yards vs a terrible USF team. Then last week failed to cover the spread by 30 points in a 49-7 loss to UCF. Meanwhile, they're taking on a surging ECU team that has covered 4 straight games and is think bowl game at 4-4.

**OLE MISS 40 Liberty 27.** This line seems short and makes us question if Ole Miss QB Matt Corral is going to play here after being banged up in the last couple of games. The other major story is the return of Hugh Freeze who coached here from 2012-2016 before a disgraceful exit. His current team, Liberty ranks in the Top 10 in ypp margin (+145.4), scoring margin (+19.6) and yards per play margin (+2.18). However, this is by far the best team they have played this season. How motivated will Ole Miss be after a SEC gauntlet? We won fading them last week on these pages. This week we think there is value on them providing Corral plays.

**Baylor 33 TCU 26.** Obviously, the major story here is the abrupt ending of the Gary Patterson tenure at TCU. The game had passed Gary by but we thought he deserved better. Especially considering what he did for this program is similar to what Bill Snyder did for Kansas St. Jerry Kill takes over for a team that has covered just one game this season. Meanwhile, Baylor is 6-2 ATS this season covering by an average of 8.9 ppg. The Bears are also No. 6 in ypp margin (+1.95) while TCU ranks No. 92 (-0.26). Only one way to go here.

**3★ Penn St 35 MARYLAND 21.** Penn St showed up last week in Columbus and surprised many in the 9-point loss as huge underdogs. It was a far-cry of what we saw vs Illinois the week prior. They need a feel-good win here after 3 straight close losses. Now they take on a Maryland team that has failed to cover the spread in 4 straight Big Ten games and couldn't cover last week vs a 3rd string true frosh QB. Penn St has revenge for losing outright as a 27.5-point favorite last year to the Terps. They get the win and cover here.

**Utah St 42 NEW MEXICO ST 24.** New Mexico St should be well rested here considering they have only played one game the last 3 weeks. The Aggies might be 1-7 SU but they have covered in 6 of their last 7 games. Meanwhile, Utah St surprisingly controls its destiny in the Mountain West and the Aggies have a relatively easy schedule remaining. How focused will they be for this one? We lean UNDER.

**Oregon St 31 COLORADO 21.** Oregon St has not been to a bowl game since 2013. They can clinch bowl eligibility with a win here. This is a big game for them but how will they handle expectations? They have already lost outright as road favorites to Washington St and California. However, the Buffs leave a lot to be desired as they have the worst offense in the country averaging just 251 ypg. Colorado is No. 120 in ypp margin. We bet UNDER 57.5 on the openers.

**ARIZONA ST 32 USC 25.** Both of these teams have failed to meet expectations this year and honestly we're not surprised. USC is a consistent under-achiever and now will be playing the rest of the season without their best player WR Drake London who sadly broke his ankle last week. Meanwhile, Arizona St has lost back-to-back games and you have to wonder about Herm Edwards' job security with the off-field recruiting investigations going on. We have a slight lean on the UNDER.

**North Texas 27 SOUTHERN MISS 23.** North Texas comes in off an OT win over Rice last week and will be looking to build some momentum. Southern Miss is just 1-7 ATS this year including 0-7 ATS vs FBS teams failing to cover by 10.4 ppg. The Golden Eagles are No. 124 in ypp margin and are down to a 3rd string QB. With that being said, they had a misleading blowout loss to Middle Tennessee last week where they allowed 3 non-offensive TD's. Pass.

**GEORGIA 48 Missouri 10.** Georgia is No. 1 in the AP Poll, No. 1 in the CFB Playoff rankings and No. 1 in any Vegas power rating. The Bulldogs are No. 1 in the country in scoring margin (+31.3) and their defense has allowed just 6.6 ppg (No. 1) so far this season. That is on pace to be the fewest in recent CFB history. Now they're taking on a Missouri team that has failed to cover the spread in 11 straight games dating back to last year by an average of 11 ppg. That's why the Bulldogs are 38-point favorites here. We bet UNDER 61.5 on the openers and still lean that way.

**Appalachian St 43 ARKANSAS ST 22.** We're not sure how many years Butch Jones is going to get in Jonesboro. This is a winning program that won with several different coaches the last decade-plus. This year's team features one of the worst defenses in college football history allowing 7.95 yards per play (No. 130) and 559.3 ypg (No. 130). Appalachian St can name the score here but we have a slight lean on UNDER.

**Ohio St 40 NEBRASKA 23.** That was not an impressive performance by the Buckeyes last week in their 9-point win over Penn St that was aided by a long defensive TD. It was the 2nd time Ohio St has struggled this year at home vs a Top 20 caliber team. In fact, Oregon and Penn St are the only Top 20 caliber teams they've played so far this season and we'll find out more about the Buckeyes in upcoming games vs Michigan St and Michigan. They shouldn't have no problem here vs a Nebraska team that will never get over the hump with Scott Frost in charge. They Huskers are now 5-18 in one possession games

under Frost after the upset loss to Purdue last week. Once again, you have a QB in Adrian Martinez that had 4 TO's. You would think after 4 years Frost would've recruited a better option at QB. He hasn't and it will ultimately lead to his downfall. Ohio St is No. 1 in ypp margin, Nebraska is a very surprising No. 11. Lean Ohio St and UNDER.

**ARKANSAS 30 Mississippi St 25.** Arkansas comes in off a blowout win over an FCS opponent and a bye week so the Hogs will be well rested. Meanwhile Mississippi St had an impressive win over Kentucky last week. Miss St QB Will Rogers completed 92% of his passes — 36 of 39 — which is an SEC record for any game with 30-plus attempts. Arkansas is No. 16 in ypp margin while Miss St is No. 77. Still, we don't see much value here.

**Smu 38 MEMPHIS 31.** We lost on these pages with SMU last week as their unbeaten season came to an end thanks to a 100-yard kick return TD by Houston in the final seconds. We like them to bounce back here provided Memphis is still playing with a backup QB as they only managed 7 points in their last game vs UCF. If starter Seth Hennigan returns, this becomes a pass.

**2★ OVER 47.5 NOTRE DAME 38 Navy 16.** The last 10 meetings have averaged 64 total ppg. We have the same head coaches the entire time so we feel past history is relevant. The OVER is 9-1 to this number in those games and the only UNDER was played in bad weather back in 2017 (wind/rain). ND's offense is improving and they're running more tempo with Jack Coan who is making quicker decisions and not taking sacks. However, the Irish defense has had tackling issues the last couple of games and will be playing without All-American safety Kyle Hamilton again.

**TROY 27 South Alabama 21.** We bet Troy +2 on the Sunday openers. It was one of our biggest power ratings disparities in recent weeks and the line has appropriately moved 6 points. South Alabama has the better stats but has played a weaker schedule than Troy. Troy has won and covered 3 in a row in the series. Make it 4 in a row as we still lean with the Trojans.

**CHARLOTTE 29 Rice 25.** Charlotte only has slightly better stats (No. 115 vs No. 121 in ypp margin) but the 49ers have played a much weaker schedule than Rice. Both teams were playing with backup QB's last week. Jake Constantine will get the start for Rice here and as of press-time we're unsure if Chris Reynolds will play for Charlotte. Our power ratings say Rice is the play here.

**Oklahoma St 27 WEST VIRGINIA 23.** How about six straight ATS covers for Oklahoma St! They destroyed Kansas last week after suffering their first straight up loss of the season to Iowa St the week prior. Meanwhile, West Virginia is off back-to-back outright upsets over TCU and Iowa St. We said last week, that your guess was as good as ours as to what Mountaineer team would show up. Oklahoma St is notably on a 6-0 SU and 6-0 ATS run in the series.

**KENTUCKY 30 Tennessee 27.** A lot of early week professional money has come in on the Volunteers in this one. Tennessee is off a bye and statistically have been the better team ranking No. 28 in ypp margin and No. 28 in scoring margin. Meanwhile, Kentucky is No. 42 in ypp and No. 53 in scoring. The two teams have played similar schedules in terms of strength. Our ratings say Kentucky is the play but we will respect that early money on Tennessee and sit this one out.

**TEXAS ST 31 UL-Monroe 27.** ULM has improved more on offense since the start of the season than arguably any team in CFB. It's a big reason why the OVER has cashed in 5 straight games for them. They're taking on a Texas St offense though that was shutout last week at ULL. The Bobcats were playing with Tyler Vitt at QB with Brady McBride out (check status this week). Our knee-jerk reaction is that this line looks pretty short but ULM has played better as of late. We're sitting this one out for now.

**IOWA ST 32 Texas 26.** Both of these teams have greatly disappointed in 2021. Both are on the outside looking in with regards to a Big 12 Championship game appearance. At least the Cyclones still look good on paper ranking No. 9 in ypp margin, and No. 10 in ypp margin while Texas is a mediocre No. 54 in ypp margin and No. 72 in ypp margin. Matt Campbell likes to talk about 5-star culture at Iowa St. He probably needs to start getting some better players as that culture can only go so far. Slight lean UNDER.

**Michigan St 27 PURDUE 24.** Before the Sunday openers, this was the game we circled as the one we wanted to bet the most on. Obviously, we wanted to play against Michigan St off that thrilling come-from-behind win over rival Michigan. However, we bet numbers, not teams and we wanted Michigan St laying more than a FG here. We made the line MSU -3 and that's where the line has been all week. We did bet UNDER 55 and that's where our lean is.

**TEXAS A&M 28 Auburn 23.** Texas A&M comes in off a bye which is something Auburn took advantage of last week in their win and cover over Ole Miss that cashed on these pages. Auburn has played the tougher schedule and has the better ypp margin at +1.43 (No. 17) vs A&M's +1.25 (No. 23) but we were hoping for a bigger point-spread here. This is a classic lay -3 with the favorite and take +7 with the underdog. With the line right in the middle, we're passing.

**3★ WESTERN KENTUCKY 44 Middle Tennessee 24.** We like WKU in this match-up. Middle Tennessee just got done blowing out a pair of Bottom 5 teams in the FBS (UConn and So Miss) and are being over-valued in the market. Especially considering they scored 3 non-offensive TD's last week to get the win and cover vs Southern Miss. On top of that, they are dealing with an injury to QB Chase Cunningham (we think he's doubtful). Meanwhile, WKU is No. 13 in the country in ypp margin. WKU's offense ranks No. 3 in ypp (533.6) and No. 3 in yards per play (7.24). The Hilltoppers just got done beating ODU, FIU and Charlotte all by 15 points or more. The Hilltoppers roll again here.



**Oregon 29 WASHINGTON 21.** Oregon is on a 14-2 SU and ATS mark in this series. The two did not meet last year and Washington head coach Jimmy Lake had some choice words for Oregon not being an academic rival this week. The Ducks should be very pleased with their No. 4 ranking in the CFB Playoff poll that was just released on Tuesday night. Although, our early projections would have them a 17.5-point underdog vs No. 1 Georgia if that match-up happened this week. Oregon is No. 20 in ypp margin while Washington is No. 66. We'd be all set in taking Oregon here but the underdog is now 8-0 ATS in their games this year. Quite simply, the Ducks play to the level of their competition. That makes this only a lean.

**California 32 ARIZONA 18.** Cal is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight covers and 2 straight wins. Meanwhile, Arizona has lost a Pac-12 record 20 straight games! However, the Wildcats have easily covered as large underdogs the last two weeks. However, unlike Washington and USC...we think the Bears will be better focused and better coached vs Arizona.

**Colorado St 21 WYOMING 20.** In case you didn't know already...Colorado St head coach Steve Addazio is an analytics nightmare! Colorado St had the ball inside the 10-yard on 4 different occasions vs Boise St last Saturday and Addazio elected to kick a FG every time including two from the 2-yard line! He elected to kick 4 short FG's (28 yards or less) vs San Jose St and 3 vs New Mexico. He had the horrific clock management in the closing seconds vs Utah St. And you want to lay more than a FG on the road with this guy? Yes, Wyoming is on a 0-5 ATS run but you're paying a premium wanting to fade the Cowboys here. We like Wyoming.

**Utah 32 UTEP 20.** Big game in CUSA here. The unbeaten Roadrunners come in fresh off bye. UTEP is 7-1 ATS with an average cover of 10.2 ppg. They have outscored their opponents by 20.6 ppg (No. 7), outgained them by 108 ypg (No. 20) and have played a tougher schedule than UTEP. Meanwhile, the Miners scored 15 points in the final minutes vs FAU last week as they covered for the 5th consecutive game. UTEP is a very solid +1.2 in yards per play margin (No. 26) and have outgained their opponents by 101 ypg (No. 23). Our ratings are right near the side and total here.

**FLORIDA ATLANTIC 28 Marshall 27.** Second straight big game in CUSA, this time in the East division. Statistically, Marshall is the much better team as the Herd rank No. 10 in ypp margin, No. 14 in scoring margin and No. 14 in ypg margin. FAU is only No. 59 in ypp, No. 41 in scoring and No. 59 in ypg. That's why Marshall is the short road favorite here if you were wondering. We bet UNDER 62.5 on the open and still lean that way.

**FRESNO ST 30 Boise St 25.** Boise St came off the bye with a nice win and cover over Colorado St. The Broncos rallied from a 16-7 halftime deficit and can thank Colorado St head coach Steve Addazio for settling for short FG's. Their opponent this week has a much better head coach as Kalen DeBoer has the Bulldogs on the verge of clinching the West Division after big-time wins over Nevada and San Diego St the last two weeks. However, this isn't a great spot for them playing a 3rd straight good opponent in conference play. We bet UNDER 61.5 on the openers and still lean that way.

**Unlv 24 NEW MEXICO 23.** Can UNLV head coach Marcus Arroyo finally win a game here? He is 0-14 SU as head coach here and last week's first half effort vs rival Nevada was terrible. They're taking on a New Mexico team fresh off a bye and also fresh off their first cover of the season beating Wyoming outright as 20-point underdogs. New Mexico is still just 1-7 ATS on the season falling short by 5.7 ppg. Our numbers actually lean UNLV here as they have played the much tougher schedule.

**Old Dominion 28 FIU 25.** Two teams that look like they are heading in opposite directions. ODU has life with a first-year coach and fresh off their first FBS win of the season. Meanwhile, the Butch Davis era looks like it is coming to an end with 4 straight double-digit losses in a row. We bet ODU -1 on the open and like them up to -2.5.

**ALABAMA 48 Lsu 17.** LSU was so banged up, they couldn't hold some practices last week during their bye. The Tigers are already playing with a lame duck coach in Ed Orgeron and we think Saban and Company won't forget the last time LSU came here, a classic 46-41 Tiger win en route to their 2019 National Championship. That feels like a lifetime ago and LSU is going to wish it were 3 lifetimes ago after Saturday night. Alabama is off a bye and only have New Mexico St on deck. They'll be plenty focused here.

**2★ NEVADA 35 San Jose St 21.** Nevada has played the slightly tougher schedule and has better stats ranking No. 33 in ypp, No. 21 in scoring and No. 35 in ypg margin. Meanwhile, San Jose St ranks No. 52 in ypp, No. 91 in scoring and No. 81 in ypg. Nevada should have revenge for blowing a 20-7 halftime lead last year that gave San Jose the West division title. San Jose St has played nothing but run-heavy teams as of late and they went 0-4 ATS earlier this year vs more pass oriented teams in USC, Hawaii, Western Michigan and New Mexico St. Nevada is the best passing team they've faced all year.

**2★ OVER 45.5 San Diego St 30 HAWAII 22.** We expect the Aztecs to rebound after suffering their first loss of the season last week to Fresno St. They're taking on a Hawaii team that has failed to cover in 3 straight games and their defense is starting to wear down allowing at least 34 points in all of those games. We bet San Diego St -6 and OVER 43.5 on the Sunday openers. Hawaii with Cordeiro back at QB should offer up some value on the OVER here.

## Tuesday, November 9th

There's no lines on these games yet but since our newsletter won't come out until next Wednesday, here are some quick thoughts.

**MIAMI, OH 32 Buffalo 25.** Both teams come in off upset losses. Buffalo somehow lost to Bowling Green despite an incredible 36-11 first down edge Buffalo ran 99 plays to BG's 46! Meanwhile, Miami fell behind Ohio 28-0 on Tuesday night and their big rally came up short. The winner needs to keep pace with Kent St in the East.

**EASTERN MICHIGAN 33 Ohio 25.** Both teams come in off upset wins on Tuesday night. EMU (+9) in a wild 52-49 shootout at Toledo. Meanwhile, Ohio (+7) hung on for 35-33 win over Miami, Oh after leading 28-0 in the 3Q. Ohio is 4-1 ATS in their last 5 games.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN 44 Akron 16.** As of press-time it is unknown how Western Michigan fared against Central Michigan. Akron, meanwhile fumbled away their opportunity for a big upset over Ball St on Tuesday night. WMU should be able to name their score here.

## Week 10 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 3-2 and are 35-42 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Ole Miss -9.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

#### Thursday, November 4th

**INDIANAPOLIS 28 N.Y. Jets 17.** Jets come in off the shocking upset of Cincinnati that crushed NFL Survivor pools across the country. In his first career start, Mike White became the first Jets QB to pass for more than 400 yards since Vinny Testaverde in 2000! Meanwhile, the Colts greatly disappointed us on these pages last week losing in OT to Tennessee. QB Wentz threw two costly INT's. The look-ahead line was Indy -14.5 so there's been a big adjustment. Slightest of calls on the home teams here.

#### Sunday, November 7th

**MIAMI 26 Buffalo 19.** One of the ugliest match-ups of the entire NFL season. Both teams have lost 7 straight games since season opening wins and both teams defenses are allowing 31 ppg in that span. The Texans had a misleading 38-22 loss to the Rams last week scoring all 22 of their points in the 4Q. Tyrod Taylor could return here as Houston was 2-0 ATS with him in the line-up. If he can't go, we think there is value with the Dolphins who probably should have covered at Buffalo last week. We're standing on the sidelines for now.

**DALLAS 30 Denver 20.** You have to tip your cap to the Cowboys who remain unbeaten ATS wise at 7-0. We faded them on these pages last week as we were hearing rumors of Dak not playing. We took Minnesota +2, they closed -4 and Dallas found a way to win the game outright with Cooper Rush at QB. This current spread says Dak will play in this one. Meanwhile, Denver broke their 4-game losing streak by holding on vs Washington last week. The Broncos have only beat the worst teams in the league and when they have had to step up in competition, they are 0-4 SU/ATS.

**2★ BALTIMORE 28 Minnesota 20.** This point spread seems a little low considering the Ravens come in angry off a bye after getting crushed by the Bengals. That loss ended their 5-game winning streak. It's clear that Minnesota head coach Mike Zimmer has lost his fast ball as the Vikings are on a 3-11 ATS run dating back to last season. Last week, they lost at home to a Cowboys team playing with a backup QB and despite being in front of a huge line move, we lost our top play on these pages. We could only look towards Baltimore here.

**New England 20 CAROLINA 17.** A pair of 4-4 teams that need this game if they want to remain in the playoff hunt at the half-way point. Carolina snapped their 4-game losing streak in Atlanta last week. The defense allowed less than 200 yards passing for the 6th time this season! Sam Darnold is a little banged up and we've seen money come in on both the Patriots and the UNDER (could PJ Walker get the start?). We have won with the Patriots on these pages each of the last two weeks. They are much better than their 4-4 record indicates. They've also been better away from home this season at 3-0. We lean UNDER. Breaking news on Wednesday morning was that Christian McCaffrey was taken off IR for Carolina.

**Buffalo 32 JACKSONVILLE 17.** Is Urban Meyer going to make a full season at Jacksonville? Off a bye facing a back-up QB and the Jags lose 31-7 in Seattle? Pathetic. The Bills got off to a slow start vs Miami last week and still won by 15. If you're afraid to lay this kind of number in the NFL, don't be. Especially with this Buffalo team that has won all 5 of their games this season by 15 points or more.

**CINCINNATI 26 Cleveland 24.** Obviously, the Browns have been a big disappointment sitting at 4-4. They're banged up on both sides of the ball and the offense hasn't topped 17 points in their last 3 games. After last week's home loss to the Steelers, they are dead-last in the AFC North! Meanwhile, the Bengals come in

off a shocking loss to the Jets as double-digit favorites. The Bengals didn't handle the favorite role too well. We lean OVER but Cleveland up to +8.5 in a teaser is really good.

**Las Vegas 24 N.Y. GIANTS 23.** The Raiders come in off a bye and are 2-0 SU/ATS with interim coach Bisaccia. However, now they're dealing with even more off-field distractions with WR Ruggs being released after a facing two felony charges after a fatal crash this week. Meanwhile, the Giants come in off the close loss to the Chiefs on MNF. We're not going to be involved here but the Giants +8.5/+9 in a teaser makes a lot of sense.

**NEW ORLEANS 23 Atlanta 17.** The Saints got a huge win vs Tampa last week but also saw lost QB Winston to a knee injury. Trevor Siemian is an experienced backup if Taysom Hill can't go with (concussion). The market hasn't moved too much off last week's look-ahead because the Falcons offense was shut down last week in a loss to the Panthers. On top of that, they lost WR Calvin Ridley. New Orleans is on a 6-1 SU/ATS run in the series but we prefer the UNDER here.

**2★ L.A. Chargers 27 Philadelphia 24.** Classic "Buy Low, Sell High" spot here. We like the Chargers off a loss to the Patriots taking on a Philadelphia team off a blowout win. It was the Eagles' biggest road win as far as margin since 1981! Meanwhile, Chargers QB Justin Herbert should bounce back after throwing that costly "Pick 6" last week. It's also a numbers play for us as we made the line LAC -3.

**KANSAS CITY 27 Green Bay 21.** Breaking news a couple hours ago is that Green Bay QB Aaron Rodgers has tested positive for COVID and will likely miss the game. What's the adjustment down to Jordan Love? So far it looks like 6 points as the Chiefs have went from 1-point to 7-point favorites at the sports books who have left the game up. Meanwhile, if it sounds like a broken record, it's because it is. The Kansas City Chiefs are the worst value bet in football right now. Now 3-15-1 ATS in their last 19 games after the underwhelming effort vs the Giants on MNF. We'll see where this spreads settles in at but we'll take the Packers at anything north of a TD.

**3★ SAN FRANCISCO 23 Arizona 20.** If you're wondering why this line is off the board at a lot of spots and is "Pick" at a few it's because Arizona QB Kyler Murray is questionable after dealing with some ankle issues. Arizona does have a couple extra days to prep after suffering their first loss of the season in the final seconds to Green Bay last week. Meanwhile the 49ers offense got going last week scoring on 7 straight possessions. The 49ers out-played the Cardinals in the first match-up. Anything with San Francisco PK or better is worth a bet.

**L.A. RAMS 30 Tennessee 22.** This is a really bad spot for Tennessee coming off 3 big wins all as an underdog. On top of it, they're on the road for the 2nd consecutive week and lost RB Derrick Henry to injury. He's as valuable as any non-QB in the NFL. Meanwhile, the Rams are stepping up in class here after playing the Giants, Lions and Texans the last 3 weeks. They did have a misleading 38-22 win over Houston last week as they actually led 38-0! We love the Rams in a teaser here down to -1.5.

#### Monday, November 8th

**PITTSBURGH 21 Chicago 16.** Pittsburgh has exceeded expectations at 4-3 this year and are coming off a big win over the Browns. However, you bet the Steelers as a dog, not as a home favorite. They're already 0-3 ATS with 2 outright losses as a home favorite this year. Chicago's offense is among the worst in recent NFL history. They've allowed 26 sacks in Justin Fields' six starts while he has only thrown 3 TD passes. They have the fewest net passing yards of any team since 2006 to start the season. Lean UNDER.
