A Little About Our Room

The indoor and outdoor space is designed to provide a safe, nurturing and exciting experience for children. Children have the opportunity to explore and choose activities that interest them, use their initiative to make independent safe choices with guidance from the teacher. They learned turn taking, decision making, play cooperatively through play, make friends and develop social skills.

Curriculum

Our curriculum activities offer creative arts and dramatic centres, science and nature, math, language and literacy activities, board games, toys, block building centre and a quiet space just to relax and read a book. Children are given snacks daily, as well as they are encouraged to join in our cooking activity preparing snacks, and enjoy and learn about the history of food and our culture. For our outdoor activities, weather permitting, there are equipment where children can enjoy climbing, jumping, balancing, and sports supplies and equipment for children to play soccer and basketball.
