January ARTIST of the MONTH Shane Boal

Shane Boal is one of the artists at The Mindscapes Gallery in room 305 of the Masonic Temple in downtown Zanesville. "I love art and science as well as: creating, learning and sharing. I'm an 8th-grade science teacher who feels most alive and authentic when sharing the things I love. To inspire others is a wonderful thing and one of my greatest joys in life. If I can encourage other artists to create or enhance their own work with something I've shared, I feel very gratified. Shared inspiration is a truly great thing to experience."

Shane's artwork is as eclectic as his interests. He stated, "I loved dinosaurs as a child and often use fossils in my work and presentations. I have large prints of the hidden details in broken fossils that I took with a digital microscope. I also have one of the better collections of phosphorescent fossils I know of. I also sculpt, use resin molds and make some of the most interesting fossil displays I've ever seen."

If Shane is curious about a subject or medium he incorporates it into his art. He has made glass galaxies to help show the relative sizes of the space between galaxies. Oftentimes his work is interactive and adaptable with changeable pieces held on with magnets and some of the jewelry he has made is entirely magnetic.

Many things he creates, react or glow in ultra-violet light. He is currently working with special lighting that makes art pulsate as the colors within them appear and disappear, and also has worked with fiber optics and electroluminescent wire.

"I hope to continue creating, sharing and promoting art for the rest of my life. I'm very happy to be a member of the Zanesville art community."
