"Country Going to Pot"

"Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body."

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

With all of the challenges facing our country, one issue that has flown a bit below the radar is marijuana use. Legalization of marijuana across the country has rapidly been increasing. Medical marijuana is now legal in 38 states. Recreational marijuana is now legal in 23 states. Efforts are being made in a number of other states to also liberalize these laws.

Many conservatives recognize that there may be a legitimate use for marijuana in medical situations, such as chemotherapy treatment. But there is a host of problems presented beyond that in this liberalization of marijuana laws. The psychoactive ingredient in marijuana is THC. In DEA seizures of marijuana in 1995 the average THC percentage found was 3.96%. In 2021 the average percentage was 15.34%. Thus current marijuana tends to be four times more powerful in terms of its psychoactive component.

The marijuana industry has been spending large amounts of money on lobbying for these liberal marijuana laws, and big companies have become involved in production and sales. They have followed the pattern once used by tobacco companies in getting young people started early with usage. Marijuana edibles are packaged as "Pot Tarts" and "Stoney Patch Kids."

According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse, usage of marijuana on twenty or more occasions in the past thirty days has reached the highest levels ever among those aged 19 to 30. The percentage of eighth, tenth and twelfth graders who used marijuana daily has more than tripled between 1991 and 2020. In 2021 1.3 million people between age 12 and 17 were categorized as suffering from marijuana use disorder. One effect of this was that in 2021 there were 70,000 emergency room visits from children under 18.

Driving under the influence is an additional problem associated with marijuana use. Detecting marijuana use is more challenging for law enforcement officers than is alcohol use. But driving under the influence of marijuana is a growing problem. In 2021 there were 2.41 times more minors charged with driving under the influence of marijuana than driving under the influence of alcohol.

Meanwhile at school in 1991 78.6% of surveyed twelfth graders believed that regular marijuana used puts one's health at great risk. In 2021 it was only 21.6% who agreed. Medical science has produced studies showing that regular marijuana use is linked to psychosis, depression, suicide, and lower IQ at a time when young brains are still developing.

It is tough to be a kid and a parent today with all of the challenges that our world is presenting them. Pray for our youth program and our youth leaders and children's program leaders to have a positive effect on these precious young people and their parents.


