

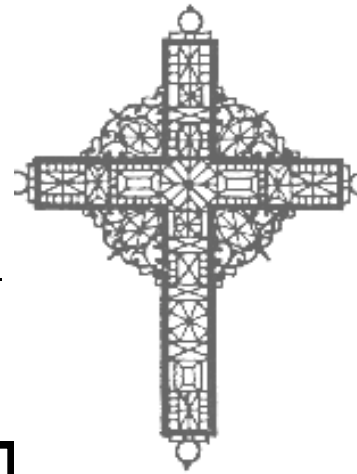

Back in 2016 I was preparing to celebrate the Easter Vigil for the first time as a pastor. That year we celebrated it at the parish that I drove to and as I was setting up and going through things in my head it started snowing at around 2:00 pm and the Easter Vigil began at 8:00. By 8:00 pm there was a good cover of snow much like we had this past week. What normally took me 35 minutes to get home to Garretson, took closer to an hour. It seems like there is a storm like this sometime in April or even May. My point for bringing this up is to remind us that we are not in control of how these things transpire. We need to do our due diligence and prepare but we also have to endure what comes our way and I think that this lesson will help us prepare for Holy Week.

This is one of my favorite times of year because it is a series of peaks and valleys. Palm Sunday is the reminder of Jesus' triumphal journey into Jerusalem and he is revered, but there is a great shift in the people's perception of him when Holy Thursday and Good Friday arrive. The same is true in our own lives; we go through moments of clinging to Jesus and relying upon him and then something changes where we want him to be as far away as possible and we choose to sin. Think of Judas, one of the twelve chosen apostles to be the closest allies and friends of Jesus. His greed and inability to see through the plans of the Jewish elders is a reminder for us to not lose focus on our relationship with Jesus. The celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper is a beautiful moment to recall when the Eucharist was instituted and afterwards we will process to the chapel to remain with Jesus while he spends time praying in the Garden of Gethsemane. On Good Friday the altars will be stripped of the linens that adorn them and the tabernacle will be empty. One of the most moving things that I get to do on Good Friday is hold the crucifix for you to venerate. As we wait for the Easter Vigil to begin there is anticipation of hearing the readings that lead us from creation Abraham to the Exodus to the Prophets to the New Testament. For some of you this is the anniversary of you joining the Catholic Church and this may have happened many years ago or more recently. Another important element of the Easter season is that we will have the opportunity to renew our Baptismal promises. This is an important moment because we get to reaffirm what our parents and godparents committed us to at our Baptism. Much like Christmas, Easter has a liturgical season attached to it and as we celebrate Easter we will hear about the Apostles and what they did to follow Jesus' words from Matthew 28: 18-20 "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

As I have mentioned in the past, I have had the privilege to visit and pray at the sites of the Last Supper, the Garden of Gethsemane, the *Via Dolorosa* (the Way of Sorrow/Way of the Cross), Calvary, and Jesus' tomb and this week, they will become very real to us as we pray about what Jesus has done for us and how God's plan of salvation includes each of us.
