Scholarship recipients also receive a yearly book allowance of \$1200 and a monthly stipend from \$300 to \$500 while attending school, depending on their year in the ROTC program. Minuteman Scholarship recipients must serve in the Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP), in which they participate in an Army Reserve unit's monthly drills and a 14-day annual training for which they are paid as a sergeant. It's the first step in the financial aid process. The FAFSA may be used as the TOPS application or parents may use the TOPS On-line Application (if you feel you won't qualify for federal aid). Plan on completing the FAFSA every year the student is in college, even if you think you won't qualify for any aid. It can't hurt to have a backup plan.
