FROM THE TRAP LINE:

We're going to have a busy summer with all of the shooting sports going on.

The Summer Trap League begins April 4. There will be 10 shoots and shooters must make 8 out of 10 shoots to shoot for a trophy. Cost is \$10 per round of 50 birds.

We encourage any junior shooters ages 12-17 to come and shoot. If any junior makes 8 or more shoots, the cost of his birds and shells will be reimbursed at the end of the season.

Shoots will be on Saturdays starting at 10:00 AM till finished. Must sign up by 11:00.

Make ups and shoot aheads will be done on the day of the regular shoot, Wednesdays and Saturdays with a limit of 100 birds per day.

There will be no make ups on Trophy Day. [50 bird limit]
