Rifle/Pistol Range Operating Procedures

Document Purpose

The purpose of this document is to provide a written guideline for the management, maintenance and safe use of the Unaka Rod & Gun Club rifle/pistol range facility located at 90 Furnace Road Johnson City, TN (hereafter called the “range”). This document only applies to the rifle/pistol range and the facilities for that range area. An abbreviated set of the rules is posted on the range. This document is designed to serve as a reference for the proper and safe conduct of all recreational shooting operations at the range.

Responsibility

The Officers and Board of Directors (hereafter called the BOD) are responsible for all aspects of the use and scheduling of the rifle/pistol range. The BOD is responsible for maintaining the physical facilities, and will assure that the facilities adhere to all Federal, State and Municipal environmental, health and safety codes.

The BOD will be responsible for the issue of keys to the range. The issue of keys will include keys for the range swing gate, target shed, range house and restrooms. Issue of keys will be restricted to club officers, BOD members and Range Safety Officers (RSO). No key to any area of the range will be reproduced or duplicated without permission of the BOD. All keys are the property of the Unaka Rod & Gun Club and must be returned to the BOD when retention is no longer warranted by the above described need. i.e. you are no longer a Range Safety Officer

The Chief Range Safety Officer (CRSO) is responsible for maintaining this document. Specifically, he/she will keep this document current with BOD decisions and NRA range operation recommendations that may apply. Any changes will be published only after BOD approval.

Each person using the range is responsible for his/her own safe conduct, the safe conduct of their guests and the safe conduct of their minor family members. Each member is responsible for acting in a manner consistent with good decorum. Unaka Rod & Gun Club is an association of like-minded sportsmen and sportswomen that strongly encourages participation in the shooting sports by their family members. It is important to the BOD that the operations of the range and all Unaka Rod & Gun Club property activities be conducted in such a manner as is not offensive or alienating to any age or gender group.
