GERMANY SOCIETY MEETING AT SPRING LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE, MARCH 5, 2022 4 PM IN BROWN HOTEL

The Meeting was called to order by President Buehler and Trustee Jessel led us in prayer which was followed by the Pledge to our Flag, then the SAR Pledge. We had a quorum with 36 dual members and 4 Primary members by a Zoom connection with Germany.

The Secretary's Report:

Requested any changes from the last meeting minutes, there being none they were unanimously accepted.

Secretary Gunn gave a Treasurers Report for Kevin Carr because he was in a meeting with OFNA. Current balance in Society's account is \$7054. This year we spent \$3943 for Germany Society Medals which should last for the next 3 years or more.

We have a 13 Primary Members some of whom have joined us with Zoom today along with a few others in Germany.

The Society has received 4 Steamers for our Colors:

- Battle of Blue Licks
- 2nd Siege of Augusta, 1781, 240th celebration
- Patriots Day St. Simeon Island
- Battle of Kettle Creek

Registrar Perkins acknowledged our newest member and President Buehler inducted Mathew E. Johnson by Zoom at 4:25 PM EST. Matthew then gave us information about his Patriot Ancestor who is Thomas Rankin whose service was explained by Matthew. His Certificate has now been signed by President Buehler and the paperwork sent to him along with a Rosette.

The first order of business was a brief presentation from a Museum Committee led by PG Dooley requesting the Germany's support for funding an authentic replica Zweibrucken uniform from the Battle of Yorktown to be placed in the SAR Museum. A

motion by Michael Adcock, 2nd by Russ DeVenney for the Society to pay for such - passed unanimously.

A brief discussion ensued between President Buehler and the Primary members regarding components necessary for their Chapter Certification [By-Laws, dues, where & how to meet (Zoom or other), etc.

There was a motion made by Steve Baldwin, 2nd by James Klingler to donate \$800 to the USO in Germany (We've donated \$500 in the past). The motion passed unanimously.

David Jessel reported that 5 ROTC Medals were sent to Germany to support the 6 units there. A Motion was made by Jack Bredenfoerder, 2nd by Michael Adcock to donate \$1000 to NSSAR ROTC/JROTC/Service Academies Liason subcommittee in support of JROTC fund-raising enhanced program.

This passed unanimously.

Election of Society Officers: A slate was announced from the Committee;


