UPDATES FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hello and happy 2018! Exciting news: the old wood dock is gone (it was taken by a local who intends to re-purpose it as a deck). With ice-out we'll have a new dock made of a durable, good looking composite called ThruFlow (http://thruflow.com/wp-content/uploads/2016/07/thruflow-brochure-2016.pdf). It will have bumpers and solar lights! Last fall Jean Bassignani, my husband and I painted the shed, and stained/preserved the fence and the picnic tables. I also had the grassy area core aerated and re-seeded. Using our new pump (thank you Tony Bonaccorsi.), we were able to water that seed during the mild autumn weather. This will hopefully make our beach lot nicer looking this coming season. We also had the parking area regraded, and the culvert that is west of the parking area re-dug to improve water flow. At the request of a member, the Beach Rules were modified to allow wheeled handicap-access devices.

Your membership dues at work:

- New dock with solar lights and bumpers to be installed at ICE-OUT spring 2018
- Water pump has been installed in the shed with hose on the shed's exterior wall
- Shed has been painted and a NON-slip product applied to ramp
- Post & rail fence repaired, stained and preservative applied
- Two new picnic tables purchased, preservative stain applied
- Lawn has been core-aerated and reseeded
- Parking lot has been re-graded and the culvert repaired to improve water drainage
- The old toy box has been recycled and a new one is in place with holes drilled in the bottom to allow water to run out. Please keep lid closed, thanks

Revisions to the BEACH REGULATIONS

(see Beach Rules for more details):

- Dog swim hours set for 9 10 am and 7:30 8:30 pm every day. Dogs must be under control at all times so as not to be a nuisance to anyone. The beach lot is a summer "bare-foot" place – clean up after your dog!
- Wheeled vehicles are forbidden on the grassy area and beach with the exception of handicap access devices e.g. wheelchairs
- Fireworks are expressly forbidden anywhere on the beach lot
- Fishing is still permitted from the dock. Please do not leave sharp objects (hooks, lures, gaffes) where someone can get hurt
- Fueling your boat or jet ski from our dock is not permitted due to the proximity of the dock to the swim area.

ELECTIONS are to held this year at the CLOSING MEETING.

 Potential candidates should contact Joan Dobbins or another officer as soon as possible to place themselves on the ballot.

KAYAK RACK

- Exists for the benefit of members only.
- There are only 26 slots.
- Each member may use only ONE slot based upon payment of \$25 to the Treasurer.
- Only the first 26 members requesting a slot at the time of dues payment will be granted a slot.
- <u>All boats on the kayak rack must be chained with a lock to the rack when not in use</u>. This is for safety and is an insurance requirement.
- ONLY use the pre-drilled holes with red painted numbers.
- Once you have placed your boat(s) in your slot, you must inform Joan Dobbins of which slot you have.
 The records are kept to be sure only paid members use the slot and that the owners are notified if there is a problem with their boat i.e. unlocked

WIA MEMEBERSHIP DUES:

- Deeded property owners may become members. Waterfront owners are welcome to make contributions towards our beach lot's maintenance and/or improvement. See By-Laws for details.
- Dues remain \$150 and are due on or before June 20th
- Only paid WIA members are entitled to use the items that we purchase/maintain/improve e.g. shed, tables, dock, swim raft, parking lot, kayak rack, bike rack, etc.
- Only paid members may use the mooring sites. See Mooring Regulations for details

MOORING HOLDERS

- Your MOORING FEE of \$175 should be sent to TREASURER Diane Farraher-Smith, 63 Walden Pond Ave., Saugus, MA 01906 on or before April 15th
- Your REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (boat insurance cover and copy of boat's registration decal) should be sent to MOORING COORDINATOR Tony Bonaccorsi, 127 Dix Street, Bridgewater, NH 03222 on or before April 15th.
- Members wishing to access a temporary mooring should submit the same paperwork as above to Tony Bonaccorsi as early as possible.
