

## Subtype Interests Defined<sup>1</sup>

- **Self-Preservation – my private world**
  - home, garden, family, solitary and personal pursuits
  - having enough resources, safety, health
  - grounded, practical, introverted
  - adjust the environment to their needs
  - *preserving*<sup>2</sup>
  - contracting<sup>3</sup>
- **Sexual/One-on-One – my intimate, creative or spiritual life**
  - love affairs, dramas, intense experiences & encounters, transcendent spirituality
  - move toward stimulation, aggressive, competitive, emotionally intense
  - most energized subtype
  - seek intimacy
  - *transmitting*
  - expanding
- **Social – my role in social activities as either a leader or a participant**
  - event planning, parties, charity work, causes, politics, fund raising
  - adapt to serve the needs of environment
  - seek long-term personal connection
  - aware of others and how they affect others, more warm, open & engaging
  - avoid long periods of quiet solitude and exclusive intimacy
  - *navigating*
  - adapting
