BREEDLOVE WINS SUDDEN-DEATH THRILLER TO CAPTURE TITLE # 2

KEIMIG UNSTOPPABLE, WINS FOR 2nd TIME

KEIMIG ON FIRE ALL DAY, CLAIMS TITLE # 2

Bret Keimig had his big strike ball working in spectacular order this month, and it enabled him to become a 2-time champion on tour. This came about due to a virtuoso performance that was just barely enough to hold off one of the Midwest's hottest players in Adam Morse.

The 20 year-old from Davenport, Iowa turned back a talented field of 8 boy's finalists, and those finalists were red-hot from the very start. In qualifying, 7 of the 8 finished with +300 or higher. They carried that stellar form over once match play began, as the 64 finals games averaged a whopping 235.73.

CHAMP WINS BACK-TO-BACK AT MAPLE

This month's competition revealed the fact that Bret Keimig has sweet affection for Maple Lanes. Exactly a year ago, the powerful southpaw was winning on tour for the very first time. That came at the October 2015 tour stop – which was, ironically, also hosted by the 32-lane Waterloo center.

This month marked the 7th time that Keimig has qualified for the match play finals. As a result of his impressive victory, Keimig vaulted from 28th to 6th on this season's boy's points list. For his 16 games, Keimig averaged 253.75. He took home the \$350 championship prize, the winner's plaque, and an official GISBT championship jersey compliments of new tour sponsor Logo Infusion. MORSE FIRES 815, 300 & 298 ON WAY TO RUNNER-UP HONORS

Adam Morse is riding the biggest hot streak of his life, and he was at it again at this month's tour stop. The tenacious 20 year-old from West Des Moines, Iowa did everything in his power to back up last month's win with another championship. He averaged 247 for his 16 games, including a 254.25 mark for his 8 finals games. His 254.25 average for the match play finals ranks at the 8th highest finals performance in tour history. In spite of this, he was forced to settle for runner-up honors due to an absolutely unstoppable performance from the eventual champion.

This month, Morse appeared in the 19th match play finals of his stellar career. Morse has been red-hot lately in events throughout the Midwest, and he's put up some eye-popping numbers in leagues and tournaments recently as well. He took home a \$275 award for his day's work.

3-TIME CHAMP DODGE CLAIMS 3rd

Anthony Dodge, the reigning Bowler of the Year, rebounded from a sub-par performance last month to claim 3rd place. The stocky southpaw won a \$225 scholarship. Dodge, from North Bend, Nebraska, was appearing in the 11th match play finals of his tour career. After qualifying in 2nd place, the 19 year-old was forced to overcome a slow start to match play, while steadily moving up the leaderboard throughout the finals. After losing his first 3 matches, Dodge won all 5 of his closing matches to charge into 3rd place.

SIKKEMA TAKES 4th

Last month, 17 year-old Seth Sikkema announced his arrival as a force on tour with a 3rd place finish. This month, he backed up that finish with another solid performance – a 4th place showing that garnered the powerful 2-hander a \$200 payday. With his back-to-back performances of the past 2 events, Sikkema has established himself as a major force on the GISBT scene. Also noteworthy this month; in his qualifying round, he recorded 80 clean frames.

ELDRIDGE RIDES HOT START TO 5TH PLACE FINISH

20-year old Blake Eldridge was this month's 5th place finisher; he pocketed \$175. The talented tweener got off to a blazing start in qualifying, firing 279 in 3 of his first 4 games, and opening his day with an 804 - the first 800 of his promising career. Eventually qualifying in 4th place, the Eustis, Florida native, actually posted the best match play record among the 8 finalists; he won 6 matches, while losing just 2. This was his 4th appearance in the match play finals over the past 2 seasons.

ROBERTS ROLLS TO 6TH

Anthony Roberts enjoyed another successful day on the lanes. The hard-throwing right-hander from Ottumwa, Iowa earned a \$150 payday for his 6th place showing. This was the 4th match play finals of Roberts' tour career. As a result of his performance, the 20 year-old zoomed from 17th to 8th place on this season's point standings.

PERDIEU PLACES 7th

Lucas Perdieu returned to the finals for the 7th time in his career, and it resulted in a 7th place finish. The DeWitt, Iowa native enjoyed a \$130 payday. Perdieu, an amiable 21 year-old, is competing in his final season on tour.

PAST CHAMPION KROL TAKES 8th

21-year old Kyle Krol rounded out this month's finals field. Krol, one of 4 past champions among this month's finalists, ran out of steam during the finals, losing his final 6 matches to drop into 8th place after qualifying in 4th. He took home a \$120 scholarship. This was the 11th finals of his career.

STARMER STROKES 290 & 803

Jonah Starmer took home the \$50 scholarship by having the highest game out of the money at this month's event. He parlayed a big 290 game into an 803 series during his qualifying round, and that 290 was enough to take home the award.

BREEDLOVE NEEDS OVERTIME TO CAPTURE TITLE # 2 DEFEATS SWANK 60-50 IN 2-FRAME ROLL-OFF

BREEDLOVE SURVIVES THRILLER TO WIN FOR 2nd STRAIGHT MONTH

Brittany Breedlove, last month's tour champion, was back in contention this month, seeking to become the first female back-to-back winner since 22-time champion Katie Maher closed the 2014-2015 season with 4 consecutive victories.

Breedlove, 18, was sharp all day, found herself in the thick of the hunt, and came on strong when she needed it most. The result was the 2nd tour championship of her career.

BREEDLOVE WINS BY THE SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

Just 34 pins separated the half-dozen girl's finalists heading into the match play finals. And the finals were nip-and-tuck all the way, but it appeared that Breedlove was in control in the late stages of match play. Her lead was 85 pins heading into the position round. But that's when things changed in a hurry. While Breedlove was losing a thriller to eventual 3rd place finisher Rebecca Broerman, Christin Swank popped a big 247 game to close out her final game. That enabled Swank to overcome her 91-pin deficit and tie with Breedlove. That meant a 2-frame sudden death roll-off would follow.

Swank won the coin-toss and decided to start first and finish last. After converting a 10-pin on her first shot, Breedlove stepped up and promptly delivered 4 clutch strikes to earn the victory. The final margin was 60-50. It was just the 2nd time in tour history that the outcome of a tournament went to overtime – and both times have come in the girl's division. The previous occasion came on August 12, 2007 when Maggie Zakrewski outlasted Kristi Mickleson and Sarah Levin in Muscatine, Iowa.

Breedlove averaged 222.92 for her 14 games. She took home a \$300 winner's check, the championship plaque, and an official GISBT champion's jersey from new tour sponsor Logo Infusion. Congratulations, Brittany!

SWANK ENJOYS FINEST DAY OF CAREER, SNAGS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Christin Swank was on the cusp on becoming a brand new champion this month, but instead settled for the runner-up spot. It was a sparkling performance in the 17 year-old's blossoming career.

The right-hander from Muscatine, Iowa enjoyed the best day of her career on the lanes, as she topped the 200 mark in all but 1 of her 14 games. She rolled into the position round 91 pins behind the leader - and a trip to the Winner's Circle at that point seemed to be highly unlikely. And that's when things got interesting, as Swank's position round 247 enabled her to track down Breedlove, eventually tying for the championship, which then required a 2-frame roll-off. Although she fell just short this time around, it appears that Swank has a bright future ahead of her in scholarship competition.

Swank's awesome showing enabled her to vault from 17th into 6th on this season's girl's points list after 3 events.

BROERMAN BAGS 3rd

Past tour winner Rebecca Broerman wound up finishing 3rd at this month's tour event. The smooth rolling 20 year-old from Mason City, Iowa snagged the high qualifier medal by averaging 223 for her first 6 games. She headed into the final position round need a big game to leap into the Winner's Circle, but a 189-186 win wasn't enough, and she would slide into 3rd place, earning a \$180 payday. This was the 15th match play round of her illustrious career.

KELLY 4th IN 4th CAREER FINALS

Michaela Kelly qualified for her 4th match play finals, and in the process, she finished 4th. The 20 year-old stroker from Bettendorf, Iowa won a \$150 scholarship for her efforts. This matched Kelly's best finish on tour; she also finished 4th at this year's season opener in Cedar Rapids.

COUREY 5th IN 3rd STRAIGHT FINALS

Cassidy Coury rolled into her 3rd consecutive match play finals of 2016-2017 in Waterloo. This month, the talented 17 year-old from Brooklyn Center, Minnesota would wind up in 5th place, securing a \$130 scholarship. Courey has become a major force on tour this season by becoming the only player in the girl's division to qualify for the finals in all 3 events. That consistency has enabled her to bowl her way into contention for the Bowler of the Year race.

MUNSON TAKES 6th

Hannah Munson completed the finals field with a 6th place showing worth \$120. The 20 year-old from Cottage Grove, Minnesota was appearing in the 3rd match play finals of her career.

Miranda Rodriguez fired a 278 to open her qualifying round, and it ended up being the high game out of the money, which earned her a \$50 scholarship.
