Your guest may give you the money, but you must be the one receiving the drink and handing the money to the bartender. If you are sitting at the bar, please have their money in front of you.

Please welcome our new Kitchen Manager, Theresa Pink. She is working hard to serve you! The kitchen is open Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday nights from 5 to 7 and Tuesday and Saturday day from 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm. Theresa has some ideas for menu items and if you have anything you would like to see on the menu, please leave us a note outside our door.

On Thursday evening, July 12th we are starting a bowling tournament. Sounds like it will be great fun. Each time you come you will draw for partners. Check the calendar for dates and time.

There has been some confusion or Red Shirt Fridays.
