







We would like to remind you that with the colder weather comes the risk of pipes freezing and breaking.

To help avoid this problem we would kindly ask that you follow the tips listed below:

If the temperature drops below 31 degrees or if you are leaving town for the holidays during the months where it could potentially freeze.....



MAKE SURE THE THERMOSTAT IN YOUR APARTMENT OR HOUSE IS SET ABOVE FREEZING.



LEAVE CABINET DOORS UNDER SINKS OPEN TO ALLOW WARM AIR TO REACH THE PIPES.



LEAVE ALL FAUCETS IN THE HOUSE (SINKS AND BATHS) DRIPPING. THE DRIP SHOULD BE APPROX. 1 DRIP EVERY SECOND WITH BOTH HOT AND COLD WATER TURNED ON. DO NOT RUN THE FAUCET IN A STEADY STREAM AS THIS COULD RESULT IN FLOODING. LEAVE ALL DRAINS OPEN.



IF RESIDENTS ARE GONE, THE MANAGEMENT MAY BE ENTERING THE RESIDENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF AVOIDING POTENTIAL PROPERTY DAMAGE FROM BURST WATER PIPES AS AUTHORIZED IN PARAGRAPH 24 OF THE LEASE.
