If you have had experience with gardening in the past, your expertise and advice would be most welcome. Others might like to actually be hands-on.

We have already identified a couple of easy areas for someone to adopt: the Bougainvillea plants on the dining room terrace and the potted plants on the entrance lanai and in the lobby. These would only require watering as needed, removing dead leaves and occasional fertilizing, which would be provided to us by Management. Other possible areas around the property would be small planting areas outside of the building. Just this small gesture will be of help to Management.
