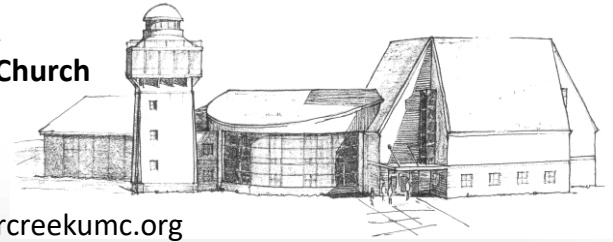
Tureen Dinner & Farewell for Joan Bindeman
