Block 7 February LeTort Quilters of Carlisle


Cutting directions:
red: (2) $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut on the diagonal once
yellow: (1) $51 / 4$ " square
white: (1) $51 / 4$ " square
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares
(4) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
blue: (4) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
purple: (4) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(1) $4 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{2 \prime}$ square

Sewing: use a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ for all seams
Gather the yellow $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " and the white $5 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ blocks. On the back of the yellow, draw a diagonal line both ways. With right sides together, stitch following the dashed lines below. Remember to stop when you hit the drawn solid line. Cut on the drawn line and press to the yellow.


Using the red squares that have been cut once on the diagonal, place one white/yellow triangle on top of one red triangle and stitch along the diagonal. Repeat for each one. You will have 4.

Gather the completed half square triangles (yellow and white), and the (4) red triangles. Placing right sides together, stitch along the hypotonus.

Press to the red side.


Gather the (4) 2 7/8" blue and white fabrics. Draw one diagonal line on each white piece. With right sides together of one blue and one white, stitch on either side of the drawn line. Repeat for the remaining 3. Cut on the diagonal line and press to the blue side. You will have (8) half square triangles. Trim to $2 \underline{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square.

Lay out the blue/white half square triangles, the $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ purple and the white according to the diagram and stitch together. You will have 4 sets.


Lay out the sections according to the block sample at the top. Stitch together. Block will measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
