- **COURSE OF FIRE**: This will be a four (4) position match consisting of prone, standing, sitting and kneeling.
- **EYEWEAR:** Safety glasses are required to be worn on the line by both shooters and coaches.

- **SCORING:** Will be done by Orion Scoring System.
- ENTRIES: A team consists of five (5) members. Registration would be appreciated by Monday, March 18th, 2019. Early registration can be made by email. Changes may be made on Saturday. Registration info required for each shooter – NRA Number (if available), <u>shooter name</u>, and <u>date of birth</u>, <u>mailing address, city, state</u> and <u>zip code</u>. Delta Waterfowl Championship Specific Rules

- **TEST:** The test will be from of the "Daisy Shooting Education 10 Lesson Curriculum"- 2012 edition and current NRA BB Gun Rule Book Specific sections will be released by March 1.
- AGE GROUPS: Age the day of the match (03/21/2019) will be used to determine the age group for individual and team awards for the Delta State Championship. Team age group will be determined by the age of the oldest team member. A Senior Division will be offered.

Delta Waterfowl AWARDS: Individual (for all classes – 8 & 9, 10 & 11, 12-15)

1st – 10th place Prone – Ribbons

1st – 10th place Standing – Ribbons

1st – 10th place Sitting – Ribbons

1st – 10th place Kneeling – Ribbons Aggregate (with test) 1st, 2nd, 3rd – Medals, 4th – 10th – Ribbons

Team Awards - Must be a SD team

Sportsmanship – All teams eligible High Team Test (5 person team) – All teams eligible

NRA BB Gun Sectional Specific Rules

Registered Tournament - This Sectional is a registered tournament, and all guidelines for registered tournaments will be followed. Sectionals are operated by match staff composed of local officials. All local challenges and protests are to be resolved on the match site according to procedures outlined in Section 16 of the appropriate NRA Rulebook. <u>Results from this Sectional will be combined with results from other locations to determine National team and individual rankings.</u>

Individual Matches - Open to any individual who meets the eligibility requirements of NRA Rule 2.3.

Categories for BB Gun (Only one category may be entered) BB1: Born 2005, 2006, 2007 BB2: Born 2008, 2009, 2010 BB3: Born 2011 or later

Team Matches - Individuals may fire on only one team per sectional and in only one of each discipline of Sectional during the same calendar year. A team is not required to fire on the same relay, but must fire at the same sectional and location. Team entry cards must have the names of all team members and alternate listed, and be submitted to the Entry Office **before** any member of the team begins individual match firing. An alternate may be named and substituted for any named team member as long as it is before either person has fired. The Team Coach must be an adult. A competitor may not fire on more than one team in any one Sectional or Sectional type in a given year. Teams are entered in categories according to age group. BB teams will be placed in the age category of the oldest member on the team.

Course of Fire: Team scores are an aggregate of scores fired by team members in the individual match. Team members must be designated before any team member fires the first shot during the individual match. "Team Only" entries will **not** be allowed.
