book 2050 page 256 Section 15. Nuisances

It shall be the responsibility of each owner to prevent the development of any unclean, unsightly, or unkempt conditions of buildings or grounds on a lot which shall substantially decrease the beauty of the property as a whole, or beauty of the specific area.


No noxious of offensive activity shall be permitted upon any lot, nor shall anything be done theron to cause embarrassment, discomfort, annoyance or nuisance to the property.

No disabled or unregistered motor vehicles shall be kept on any lot. There shall not be maintained on any lot a plant, animal device or thing of any sort that the normal activities are in any way noxious, dangerous, unsightly unpleasant or of such a nature that may diminish or destroy the enjoyment of the property.

To sum it up, we should keep up our properties to the best of our abilities.

OUR PONDS

We are starting a new environmentally friendly process to keep our ponds healthy. No chemicals will be used in the pond and algae eating plants will be placed in the pond and a natural barrier of plants will be left around the perimeters.



Lawn Cutting

This is a reminder to keep up with your grass cutting. The HOA will be monitoring for grass that is not cut on a regular basis. A reminder letter will be sent to homeowner's with a 10 day window to have your grass cut. If no action is taken the HOA will contract someone to cut the grass at a charge to the homeowner.
