Cunningham described her runs at the BBR... the first run was the slot race run and he was working very well and sharp; but when we went around the third barrel he slipped and shot him at the wall on the right. I had to line him back out and it really cost us a big check. The second run was just fantastic--I cannot say he made one mistake. He was fast and quick around every turn and just made a flawless run; when I saw the time I was so excited. I had lost my voice earlier in the day and I couldn't scream so I threw my hat in the air just like the bull riders do-I was so overcome with emotion. This was such a sweet win in that my husband. best friends and my sweet 4 year baby stepdaughter, Kinslee were there...she just loves barrel racing and is consumed with horses.

VF FAMOUS FOOSTER is owned, raised and bred by Danny Ray of Victory Farms. He was on the racetrack and did very well—he was AAA and won close to 30k. Danny knew he would make a great barrel horse and when he showed him to me—it was love at first. He was started on the barrels when I got him in October of 2015 and I just continued on—he was a really good horse to train—just had to learn my style and it just fell into place. He was like most colts; you do repetitive training and just one day it all clicked and he just wanted to be a barrel horse! My best training tip would be to keep your horse happy and bond with him and he will go the extra mile for you.

VF FAMOUS FOOSTER is just a very happy horse. He loves just going and doing and is very personable; he loves people and he's

...owned by Victory Farms really athletic and just an awesome individual. He is a large horse about 16.1 hands. He just wraps a barrel, turns quick and is just fast. He is just a blessing to be around!

He really has not been hauled all that much. I took him to two jackpots and made a run on him at Glen Rose in February and entered him in Kinder. I could just feel he had it in him--he ran the fastest time at D&D in Waco--I was assured he was something special. I just had to get myself back in the game mentally and physically. I have been out of competition for three years and it had been longer since I have trained colts, so I had to get updated on new methods and change a few things. Danny Ray and Hallie Ford really helped me with that, and my husband, Ronnie Edwards helped with my mental challenges.

Danny Ray called me about March of last year and asked me to start some colts. He always has had some great bred, fantastic horses--I just wondered what I could do with those kinds of horses so it was a challenge. But in order to jockey I had to lose about 30 pounds so I went to work on that and by December I had lost that weight. Working together has been a great fit for both of us as we get along really well.

He has a lot of great people up there, as well as I have great friends and family surrounding me. I normally have only trained my own horses for the last 10-15 years and worked full time as a tax accountant, BUT at 40 years old God put this path in my view and so I just had to step out on faith and go with it. I had no idea what is in store for me but it is sure looking good so far...

The plan for 2016 is to keep going and hopefully pick up some good checks along the way and have a lot of fun, fun, fun!
