Thank you to everyone who is following the guidelines and leaving your children at the door without coming into the foyer. May we just remind you that to avoid social contact that only one person comes up the path.



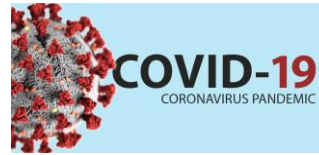
We would like to celebrate Grandparents Day on Oct 4th, we hope the children will enjoy giving their cards they made to their Grandparents
