“... the only great tragedy in life, is not to become a saint.”

The above quote was meant to be an attention grabber for all of you so that it would convince you to read this article. The full quote goes like this: “The only real sadness, the only real failure, the only *great tragedy* in life, is not to become a saint.” It was written by French Catholic Leon Bloy who wrote novels, essays, and poems. His famous ‘saint’ quote is quite a bold statement and you may wonder how such a statement could be true when there are so many tragedies that happen in our world. The answer is using this famous quote in the right context.

Yes, there are many tragedies such as children being killed, people dying from cancer, people starving in the world, etc. etc. But these tragedies take place in the earthly realm and not in the spiritual realm of heaven and hell. The tragedies that occur in our world are temporary. But where we spend eternity after our Personal Judgment is permanent and forever.

A soul must be perfect to enter heaven and purgatory ‘purges’ the sins and negativity that may still cling to our souls. I tell people all the time- ‘Don’t be afraid of purgatory because if your soul is in purgatory that means you are eventually going to heaven!’ Purgatory makes you a perfect saint that is ready to enter heaven and you will enjoy the rewards of heaven forever!

But a soul that does not become a saint will be sent to hell. And the punishment of hell will last forever with no hope of escape. This tragedy lasts forever so now you can see more clearly why “the only great tragedy in life, is not to become a saint.” This quote becomes much more poignant when applied to our lives after our time on earth.

This week we will be celebrating the Holy Day of Obligation of All Saints. We recall all the men and women and angels that have inspired us to live out our baptism and work hard at becoming saints ourselves. Who is your favorite saint? Mine is the Little Flower- St. Therese of Lisieux whose Little Way and childlike love of the Lord has always comforted me. My second favorite saint is another Teresa- St. Teresa of Calcutta who helped the poorest of the poor in India. I share one of her quotes with all of you quite often- ‘God does not care if you are successful. He cares if you are faithful.’

You will have three chances this week to be faithful to this All Saints Holy Day of Obligation so check the Mass times to the left of this article and make it a priority to attend. To be a saint is to be ‘holy’ and express our faith in a way that glorifies God and helps our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Live out your baptism and become a saint that will spend eternal life with All Mighty God in heaven!
