

Modern slavery generates over \$32 Billion each year for slave holders (International Labor Organization).

\$15.5 Billion is estimated to be made in wealthy industrialized countries, such as the US, each year (International Labor Organization)

It is estimated that 29.8 million people are currently in slavery today (Global Slavery Index 2013)

Approximately 60,000 people living in the US are enslaved today (The Washington Post, 2013)

According to the United Nations Educational, Scientific, Cultural, Organization (UNESCO), 67 million children are not in school worldwide- 28 million of which are caught in armed conflict (UNESCO, 2008)

In the US, 22% of children are living in poverty today (NCCP)
