MEET Bucky

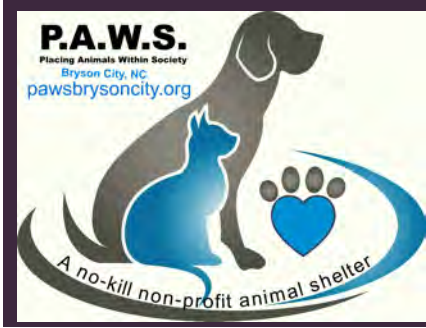
Bucky was hurt, hungry and desperately looking for help. A Good Samaritan kept seeing Bucky scavenging for food and she knew he needed help.

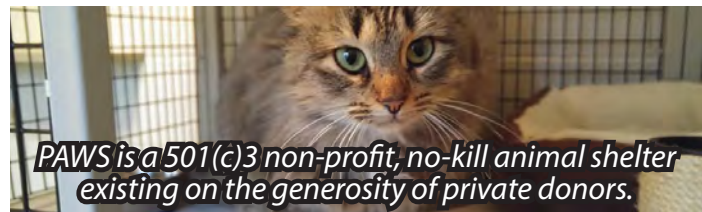

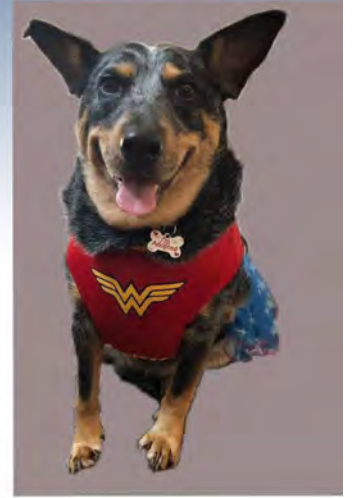

He walks a little funny which might be from previous injuries or from the gunshot wounds but our vet has given him a big thumbs up on having a great life with no residual effects from his previous injuries. Story is now living his best life, thanks to you, our donors.

Meet Bridge....

He was struck by a car and left to die, luckily a good Samaritan stopped to help him. She called our Director because it was after hours and drove him to Junaluska Emergency hospital to meet Beth, so he could receive the emergency care he desperately needed. Bridge had obviously lived on the streets and never had human touch or interaction. He is now learning from the other dogs at our shelter that not all humans are bad, that the majority of humans care about animals and want to help him heal.

Bridge is learning how to be a happy carefree dog that plays and interacts with other dogs and people.

His days of trying to survive on the street are over. Never again will he have to worry where his next meal will come from or when.

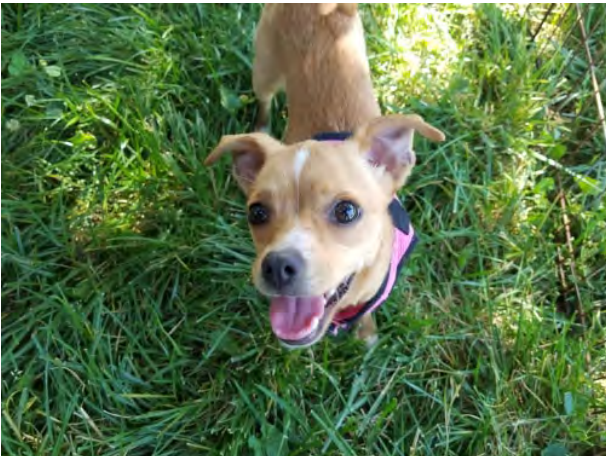
