¹⁴Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. 15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. 16 From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

Harborcreek Backpack Program - a great way to make an impact on the lives of the children in our community!

Did you know that 4 out of 10 students in the **Harbor Creek Elementary Schools** qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch program? These children rely on resources such as free or reduced-priced school breakfast and lunch to meet their hunger needs. The children face a unique challenge when they go home for the weekend - wondering where their next meal will come from. The Backpack program provides children in poverty with

nutritious food that is necessary for physical and cognitive development. The Second Harvest Food Bank announced that three Harbor Creek Elementary Schools: Clark Elementary, Rolling Ridge Elementary and Klein Elementary would be added to the program providing food for up to 120 students each week till the end of the school year.
