Policies and Procedures

The client hereto agrees as follows:

1) **Liability Policy:**

Walk Hike Play agrees to provide services stated in this contract in a reliable and trustworthy manner. In consideration of these services and as an express condition thereof, the client expressly waives any and all claims against Walk Hike Play unless arising from gross negligence on the part of Walk Hike Play.

Walk Hike Play cannot be held responsible for pets that cause damage to furniture, carpet, flooring/woodwork, walls, etc. while walker is not present.

Walk Hike Play cannot be responsible for pets that bite, suffer an accidental death or escape from faulty fencing or from inside the home due to faulty screens, doors, etc.

Walk Hike Play cannot be responsible for any complications pets may suffer or actions of pets while they are left unattended inside the home.

Walk Hike Play is released from all liability of injury to dog(s) caused by other dog(s) or animal(s) not under the control of the walker.

Walk Hike Play shall not be held responsible for the loss, injury, death, or actions of any pet has access to the outdoors while walker is not present. This includes pets with dog doors and outdoor pets.

The client understands that all pets must have a veterinarian and must be up to date on the rabies vaccination or titering and flea treatment. Client agrees to reimburse Walk Hike Play for all costs (including, but not limited to, medical care and lost wages) associated with contracting any ailments while exposed to pet(s). Client agrees to be responsible for all costs (including, but not limited to, medical care, attorney fees, etc) if client's pet should bite another person or animal.

Walk Hike Play does not diagnose or make therapy decisions. Any veterinary/medical concerns will be referred to a veterinarian. Walk Hike Play has permission to transport pets to approved veterinarian or a veterinarian of choice if the approved veterinarian is not available should a medical emergency arise. Walk Hike Play will make every effort to contact the owner and emergency contact in case of sickness or emergency, but the client gives Walk Hike Play permission to authorize the veterinarian to approve any medical care and treatment necessary and the client will be responsible for payment. Walk Hike Play will be available for emergency situations at an hourly rate of \$30. Walk Hike Play also requires that all clients provide a nearby emergency contact who can be available should an emergency occur to take over full time care if suddenly needed due to owner illness or natural disaster.

Cancellations must be received by 8pm the day prior to service in order to avoid being charged for the service. Business hours typically fall between the hours of 8a.m. and 8p.m. and services and client communications are usually completed during this time, unless prior arrangements have been made. Walk Hike Play cannot meet specific time requests, and it is understood a two-four hour window is acceptable.

Payment is expected before or at the time services are rendered for single bookings. Regular clients are invoiced at the end of the month. Payment is accepted by cash, check, or credit card. A \$35 fee is assessed on bad checks. Payment is accepted by cash, check or credit card. An invoice will be sent via email to pay by credit card. In the event of additional unforeseen visits or other costs (such as food, supplies, or vet fees), payment is expected within 10 days of the completion of services or a late charge of \$20 will be applied.

Both parties reserve the right to terminate service at any time.
