

My Jimi Hendrix Cover

I started this very difficult project by searching books and the internet to find pictures of Jimi Hendrix. Once I selected the pictures, I started assembling my design for my PYSCHDELIC Jimi Hendrix cover. I placed Jimi Hendrix in his blue jacket with the guitar behind the psychedelically colored Jimi Hendrix staring straight at you. To the right, and overlapping the psychedelically colored Jimi Hendrix, is a picture of him in an orange shirt and pink vest with another guitar.

I printed my PYSCHDELIC Jimi Hendrix cachet on the envelopes. Then I put 4 of the Jimi Hendrix MUSIC ICON stamps on them, because they make a pretty cool looking pattern. After that, I sent them to get cancelled.

After getting them back, I was very happy with the final product. I hope you are, too.
