C. Consider and Discuss Ordinance No. 0-2022-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CISCO, TEXAS, AMENDING APPENDIX A "ZONING" OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; SPECIFICALLY, SECTION 23 "DESCRIPTIONS/DEFINITIONS OF USES" ADDING A DEFINITION OF A SHORT TERM RENTAL, AND SECTION 22 "SCHEDULE OF USES" REGULATING THE PLACEMENT AND RENTAL OF SHORT TERM RENTALS; REPEAL PREVIOUS ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Second Reading)

Motion was made by Councilmember Johnston to accept the ordinance as presented. Motion died for lack of a second.
