


# **Educator Dashboards Update**

#### **Educator Dashboards**

- Tool for all educators to more quickly access robust data and view it in a user-friendly format
- Includes data from local student information systems (SIS) combined with additional state-provided data
- Accessible by teachers, counselors, school leaders, and district central office staff
- Designed to promote efficient use of data in driving educational decisions



## **Project Update**

Element	Progress
Development	<ul> <li>Dashboards: Complete</li> <li>Data Platform: Nearly Complete</li> <li>SIS Interfaces: Complete</li> </ul>
Onboarding	<ul> <li>Process varies by SIS vendor</li> <li>Dependent on district readiness, SIS vendor capacity, state capacity</li> <li>Will occur in waves</li> </ul>
Training	<ul> <li>Materials under development for both technical support and educator users</li> <li>Supported through CORE</li> </ul>

- 8 regional trainings offered over the summer
- Districts are encouraged to send one instructional lead and one technical lead
  - Instructional: Focus on dashboard functionality and instructional use
  - Technical: Focus on supporting dashboard use, troubleshooting, and key support contacts

### **Important Clarifications**

- EIS is not going away this year
- State-hosted districts will be integrated first and the state is working on a strategy to load data from non-state-hosted districts
- This is a marathon, not a sprint
