Average separation/retirement (individual) Air Force PCS Cost - \$8,548

271 Exiting Military acknowledged staying in the local area
With data input estimated that 20% (54) will use PCS to
relocate in local area

217 (not using PCS) x \$8,548 = **\$1,854,916**154 Exiting Military are Unsure of staying in the area —
after meeting with CareerSource Okaloosa Walton to learn local career opportunities, it is estimated 20% (39) will remain in the local area.

39 x \$8,548 = **\$333,372**

(UCX) Unemployment Compensation for Ex-Service Members Savings: \$589,050

Florida maximum weekly UCX payment is \$275.00 for up to 14 weeks; \$3,850 per individual 462 eligible Exiting Military Eligible for UCX Benefits

(Deducting the 273 Military retiring that are not eligible for UC from the 735 that identified years of service on survey)

With CareerSource assistance to secure job placement within 7 weeks

462 Eligible @ 80% placement within 7 weeks = 370 individuals@ 7 weeks of payment of UCX @\$275/week = \$712,250
