According to new guidelines the Robert Koch Institute (RKI) recommends that a "once clearly increased value" for IgG antibodies to Bordetella pertussis proves recent infection (1).

The PT-100 band on the Bordetella pertussis ViraStripe® IgG is calibrated with International WHO Standards (2) and - when reactive - presents supportive evidence for a recent contact with Bordetella pertussis (3).

Thus it is possible to confirm an infection with Bordetella pertussis by means of serology if vaccination has not been received 36 months prior to testing.
