## St. Cloud 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament Rules

This is a double elimination tournament. You play until you lose twice or become the champion. The action on and off the court will be fast paced so it will be important for your team to stay together. Many of the games will be played back to back so keep an eye on the brackets for the location and time of your next game. Some teams may have to play multiple games in a row, so it is strongly suggested to have 4 players.

- No refunds will be issued to teams after the entry deadline.
- The winner is (grades 4<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup>) the first team to score 15 points if winning by 2, or the first team to reach 20 points **OR** (grades 9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup>) the first team to score 20 points if winning by 2 or the first team to reach 25 points.
- There will be referees for all grades.
- If neither team has the required points, the highest score at the buzzer wins. **If the game is tied at the buzzer, keep playing, the next basket wins.** You do not need to win by 2.
- 1 point per basket-2 points if shot is from the 3 point range.
- Each game will be 15 minutes long. A coin flip will determine the first possession.
- The ball will be taken out at, or back to the top of the key on a change of possession.
- One pass must be made to inbound the ball before you shoot.
- Free throws will be awarded after 5 fouls. If fouled and made the shot the shot counts and you get the ball back. **All disputes will be settled by the referee and all decisions are final.** 4<sup>th</sup> grade will shoot 13' free throws.
- Substitutions made only at a change of possession at the top of the key – keep play moving.
- No taunting or fighting! **Fighting will result in immediate team expulsion!!**
- Each team is allowed a maximum of 4 players on a team.
- All Girls brackets and Boys brackets 4<sup>th</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> will use a 28.5" ball. All others will use a standard 29.5"
- No jewelry allowed on any of the players.
- St. Cloud Athletic Club is not responsible for injuries. Please provide your team with medical supplies as needed.
