To our members...... Nomination of trustees TODAY

This congregation (LaSalle church of Christ) was incorporated March 29, 1944 under Article 9 of N.Y. Religious Corporations Law. We are a tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. By law, being incorporated requires having trustees and by-laws. Two trustee's terms expire this year (Oct. 7th). They are Ray McArthur (Chairman), and Wayne Carter (Assist. Treasurer).

These two men may be nominated as well as other men.

Men nominated are to be baptized members of the Lord's church and a member of this congregation in good standing for at least two consecutive years immediately prior to his nomination as a trustee.
