



The Sister Paulette Williams, RSM, Awards for Outstanding Service

Funded by the CCHS Foundation

Background

- The CCHS Foundation seeks to recognize and encourage those members of the CCHS staff who are most impactful in inspiring and helping our students to be their best.
- The CCHS Foundation Board of Directors' hope is that these awards will validate, motivate, and inspire our current and future CCHS educators.
- The Board seeks to do this in a meaningful way. To that end, the Board, with the support of its generous donors, sponsors 5 annual awards of \$5000 each.
- Potential recipients will be nominated by members at large in our CCHS community.

Purpose

The Sister Paulette Williams, RSM, Awards are intended to inspire and honor Charlotte Catholic High School's staff in their roles as educators and mentors. Additionally, the Board seeks to engage the entire CCHS community in this process by conducting an open nominations process and announcing the awards at Graduation. By presenting the Sister Paulette Williams, RSM, Awards for Outstanding Service, the Board aims to establish a tradition of encouraging and rewarding excellence, and to further the overall educational and spiritual growth and achievement of CCHS and all its students.

Eligibility

Current CCHS students, parents, faculty, and staff are encouraged to nominate any and all CCHS educators who make a positive impact at our school. Winners will be selected from those who meet the following criteria:

- Nominees who have completed 3 or more consecutive years of service at CCHS and have not won this award in the past two years. (Recent winners not eligible for 2019: Adamian, Bier, Cook, Garmilla, Kennedy, Pendleton, Riter, Shaia, Sigwald)
- Employees in good standing with CCHS/MACS
- All certified non-administrative staff (teachers, counselors, librarians)
- Teach a minimum of a 4 class schedule or the equivalent (approximately 75% FTE)
- No limitations by grade/class level

Criteria

- Impact on students
- Use of best practices
- Exceptional dedication, knowledge and skill that inspires students to learn and engage
- Respect of others in the CCHS community
- Engagement in the CCHS community
- Commitment to the overall mission and success of CCHS
- Exhibits the best qualities of faith and mercy in interactions with students and colleagues

- Considers the whole student and encourages students to be their best selves in all aspects of life

Process

- Open nominations - nominations may be made by any current parent, faculty member, staff member, or student in the CCHS community; however, self-nominations are not allowed.
- Nominations must be made using the available form, providing all requested information.
- Nominations will be accepted for approximately a two-week period in April
- A description of the award and the nomination form can be found on the CCHS Foundation webpage.
- Nominations should be submitted to either the CCHS Foundation e-mail address, CCHS Foundation PO Box, or a drop box provided at school in the Counselors' Office. All mailing specifics are available on the Nominations Form.
- A Committee consisting of 5 people (2 CCHS Foundation board members, 2 award winners from the presiding year and 1 administrator) will review the nominations and recommend the award winners to the Board for confirmation.
- Complete confidentiality will be required on the part of the committee members.
- A final decision will be approved by the CCHS Foundation Board.
- Awards will be announced at Graduation immediately preceding the announcement of the Verbesey Award.

Notes

- These awards will in no way change or impact the Verbesey Award, though the decision will be made in concert so not to duplicate award winners in the same year.
- Per IRS Tax Code, these awards (\$5000) are a taxable event for the recipient.
