Dear OLSS Families,

Starting this Friday, grades K-8 will be attending Stations of the Cross in the Historic Church on Fridays during Lent, from 2:00-2:35pm. Stations of the Cross commemorates the events of Good Friday, specifically the journey of Jesus Christ from his condemnation to his crucifixion and burial. There are 14 stations, each representing a significant event in Jesus' final hours. Father Bob and the altar servers move from station to station, as students read along in the books and meditate and pray. The stations are:

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death
- 2. Jesus falls the first time
- 3. Jesus takes up his cross
- 4. Jesus meets his Blessed Mother Mary
- 5. Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus carry the cross
- 6. Veronica wipes Jesus' face
- 7. Jesus falls the second time
- 8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem

- 9. Jesus falls the third time
- 10. Jesus is stripped of his clothes
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the cross
- 12. Jesus dies on the cross
- 13. Jesus' body is taken down from the cross and placed in the arms of his Blessed Mother Mary14. Jesus is laid in the tomb

This devotion is considered a way for us to spiritually journey with Jesus through his Passion and death. Parents are welcome to join us for Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent.
